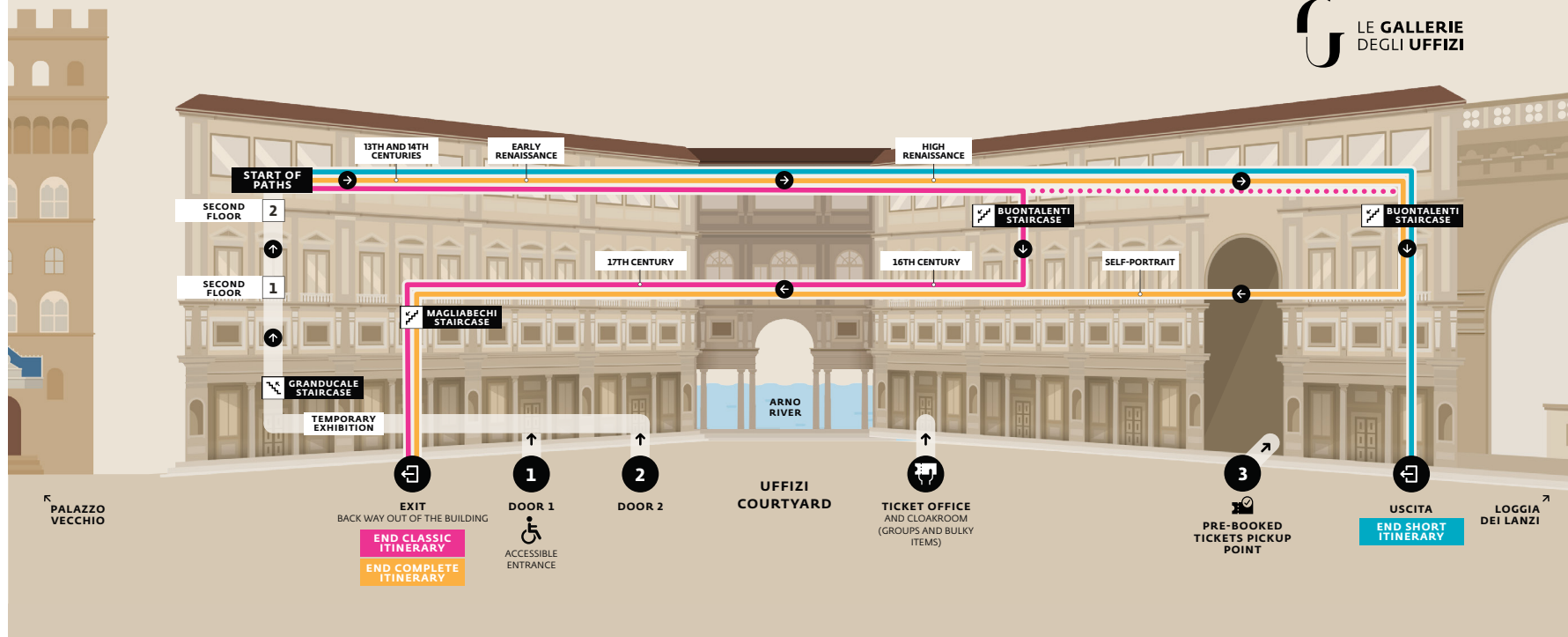

CLASSIC ITINERARY

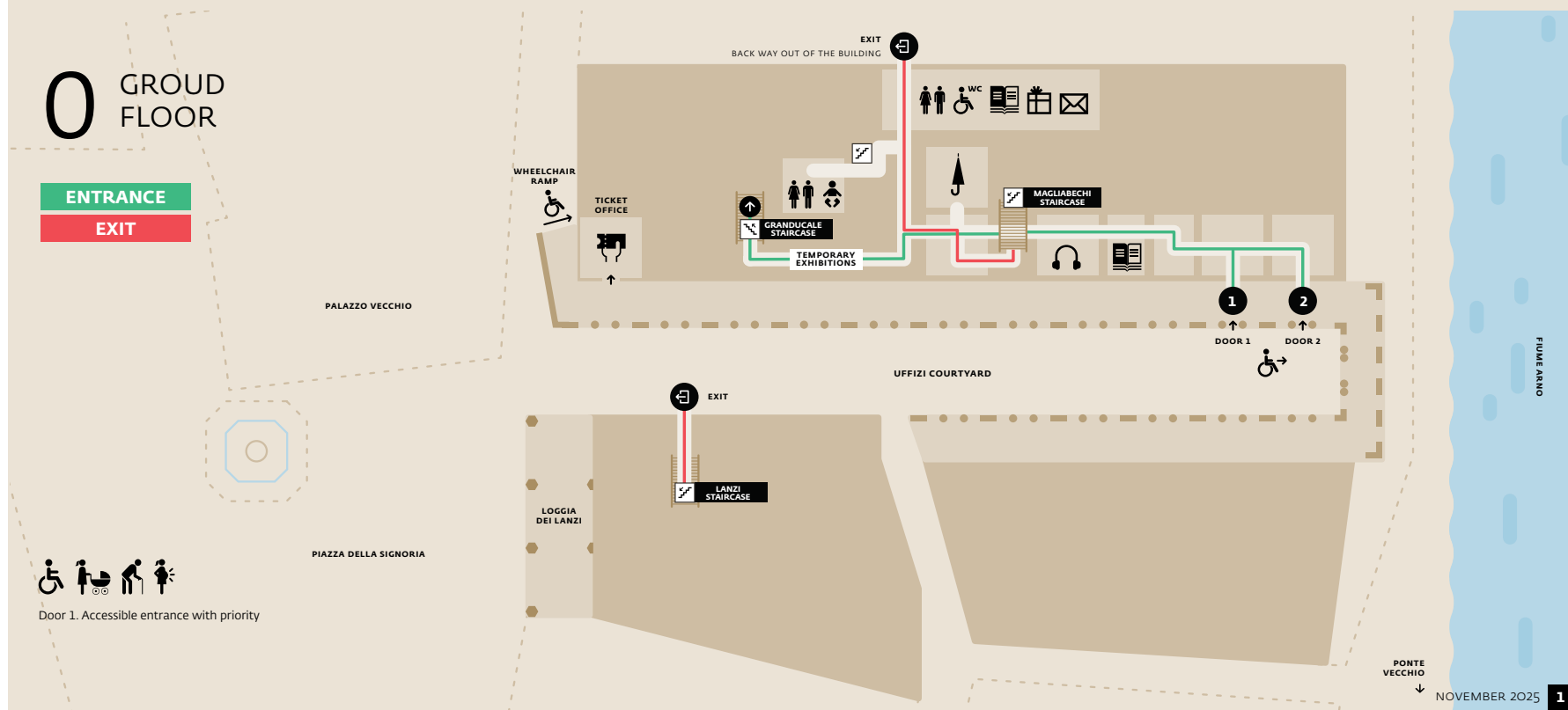

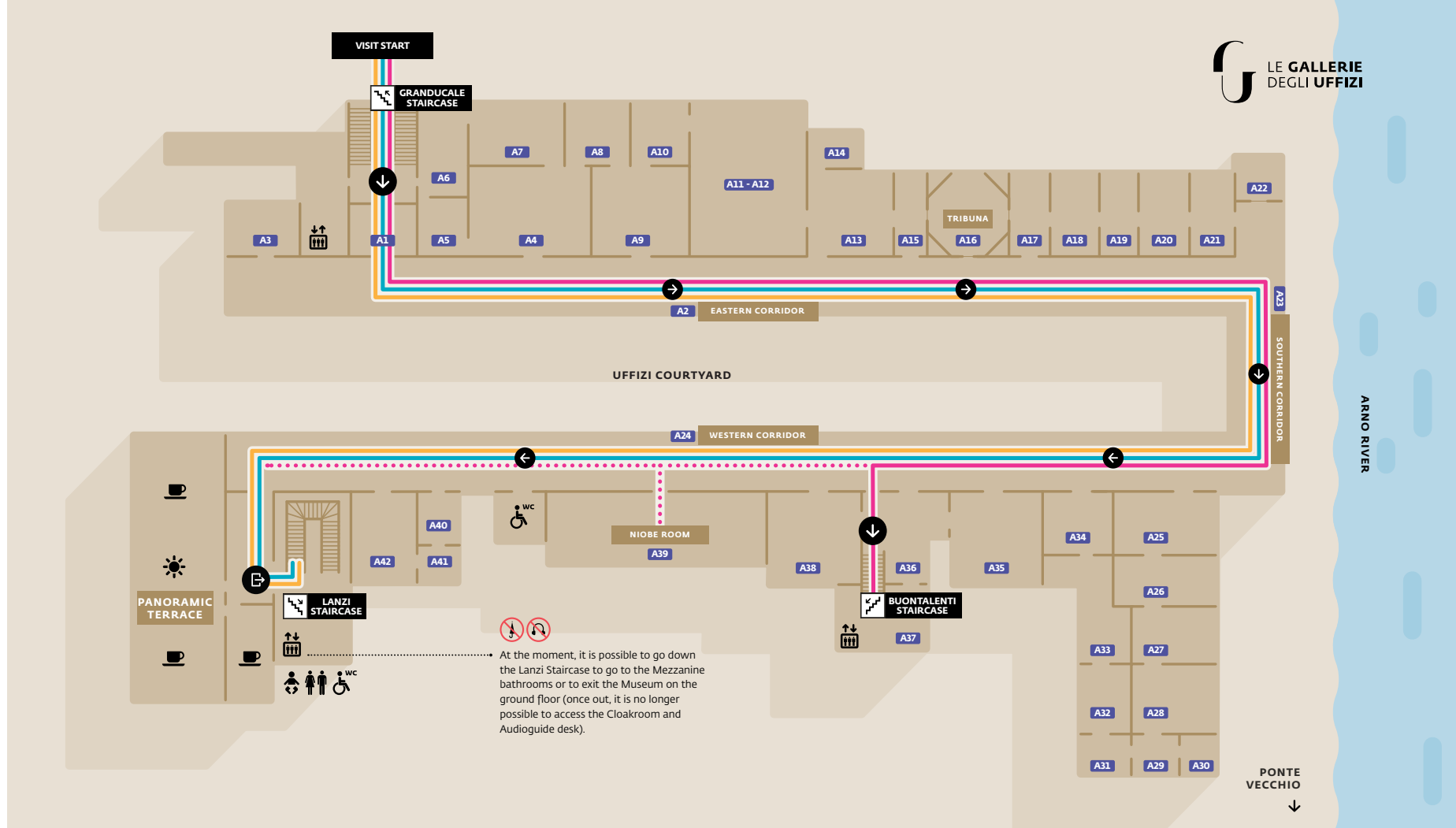

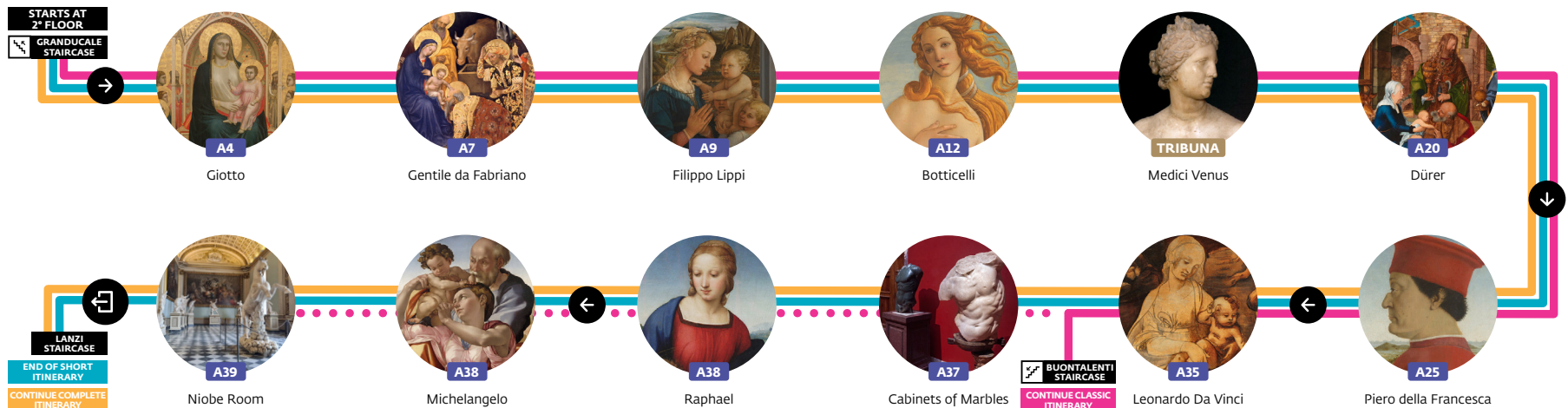
