- PROFOUND-

Pre-Treatment Instructions:

- Hydrate- we recommend that for 1 week before you moisturize skin in the morning and evening and be sure to drink lots of water to completely hydrate your skin and optimize results
- You may be provided with an antiviral prophylaxis to take 1 day prior to the treatment. Please let the clinic know if you are prone to cold sores
- Topical Retinol as well as AHA/BHA's need to be stopped 5 days prior to treatment and can be started again 10 days following.
- Please avoid sun exposure as much as possible before and after treatment, ensure you are using a Zinc Oxide SPF 30+.
- Arnica and/or bromelain tablets may be taken pre and post procedure to reduce swelling and bruising

*Please wear comfortable clothes the day of your procedure. A button up or zipper up shirt is best as we treat down the neck *

Post-Treatment Instructions:

- Immediately after Profound most patients will experience redness/swelling and slight bruising.
 Expect the swelling to grow until day 3-4 after treatment. Some swelling and bruising may last up to 14 days after treatment
- Please apply cool compress/ice packs to your face immediately following treatment and 20 minutes of every hour while awake for the next 3 days
- Eating fresh pineapple or taking bromelain and arnica supplements can help to limit swelling and bruising
- Avoid scrubbing the area, you can gently wash your face and neck with a Hexam cleanser 2 times daily and follow this by applying Aquaphor or a gentle moisturizer for a week following treatment
- Sleep with your head slightly elevated for the first 3 nights following Profound
- Avoid lifting, straining, and exercise until swelling is resolved, typically 1 week
- Avoid sleeping with pets for the first 48 hours and keep hair tied back away from your face
- Avoid sun exposure to reduce chance of hyperpigmentation for the first 3 months after treatment.
 Zinc Oxide SPF 30+ can be applied 48 hours following the treatment
- A light mineral makeup or Oxygenetix foundation can be applied following the first 48 hours to cover redness
