Early arrivals.

Shavings and Stable Allocations.

Shavings pre-ordered will be placed outside your stable. Additional shavings can be purchased on Nominate (this includes during the event). <u>http://tinyurl.com/mrx8atmn</u>

Stable allocation will be emailed to all competitors. Please be patient, we will endeavour to meet your requests, but this is not always possible.

There are three stable locations: Competition Stables, Grand Prix Stables and the Luxury Stables. A venue map will be included with your stable allocation. All stables have rubber-lined floors and are very comfortable. Riders in CDI classes and those on-site for the longest time will receive priority in stable allocation.

Please bring your own feed bins, water buckets and stable cleaning equipment.

Stables not left swept clean on departure will <u>not</u> be refunded their \$200.00 stable bond.

Hoof black cannot be used on the bitumen roads or outside the stables on any concrete or road surface. Hoof black staining will also incur the \$200.00 stable bond fee.

Horses entered in CDI competitions.

All CDI competitors please ensure you have downloaded the FEI Horse App <u>https://inside.fei.org/hub/it-services/mobile-apps/%20fei_horseapp</u>.

The FEI Horse App requires competitors to complete certain requirements in the lead-up to and during the competition.

- It is a requirement that FEI competitors record their horse's temperature for 3 days prior to arrival at the venue. This should be loaded onto the FEI Horse App.
- The CDI Health Arrival Inspection & Passport control will take place on Thursday 22 February from midday at the Competition Stables.
- The CDI Fitness Inspection (Trot-up) will take place on Thursday 22 February afternoon at approx. 5.30pm, a timetable will be posted.

Travelling from Interstate and need to know the Willinga Park PIC no.

Cattle Ticks: Please note Willinga Park is considered a High-Risk Tick venue which means QLD competitors will require spraying before crossing the border.

Fire Ants: Horses travelling from Fire Ant infested areas MUST NOT bring hay into NSW.







Electric Scooters

Electric Scooters are allowed at Willinga Park with the below rules.

- Helmets must be worn at all times when mounted on an E-Scooter
- Doubling is not permitted (one person only per scooter)
- Speeding will not be tolerated; the maximum speed limit is 10KPH
- Scooters are not to be ridden in stable aisles and must not be left where they become a hazard to other members of the public.
- Scooters will be confiscated until the end of the event if E-Scooter rules are broken.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome at Willinga Park and must be always on a lead. No dogs allowed on arenas.
