CODE OF CONDUCT

Abuse – cruel and violent treatment of a person or animal.

Abusive behaviour towards any personnel involved in the organisation and running of this event will not be tolerated. Any person inflicting abuse upon such personnel will be asked to leave the premises and all entries will be forfeited.

The FEI requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the Horse must be paramount. Welfare of the Horse must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO WILLINGA PARK

Upon entering Willinga Park for any reason (including competitions, events or accommodation) you accept and adhere to the conditions of entry outlined below:

- 1 No rubbish is to be left on the grounds of the property.
- 2 Children under 12 must be supervised at all times.
- 3 You must follow all signs and instructions.
- 4 You must adhere to and follow all directions and regulations displayed.
- 5 Vehicles will be required to leave the grounds if a vehicle is found to have been driven recklessly or dangerously and/or the driver is not adhering to directions.
- 6 No commercial photography/filming is permitted without prior approval.
- 7 **By participating in the competition and attending Willinga Park, you:**
 - a. acknowledge and agree that you and your activities may be photographed, filmed, recorded, broadcast, narrowcast, stored or reproduced in any form of media by Willinga Park personnel, companies associated with Willinga Park and accredited third-party media organisations (collectively, **Media Organisations**); and
 - b. consent to the Media Organisations publishing your results and using your name, image, likeness and voice in any form of media, indefinitely, for commercial, educational, promotional and marketing purposes associated with the competition, equestrian sport and Willinga Park, without payment or compensation.
- 8 **Photography, filming and media**
 - a. This is a closed media event. Only photographers, videographers and media personnel formally appointed or accredited in writing by Willinga Park may capture professional, editorial or commercial photographic or video content during the event.
 - b. Only official performance photographers appointed by Willinga Park may reproduce, advertise, license, supply or sell photographs of competitors or performances. Media accreditation alone does not authorise the sale of competition or performance photographs.
 - c. Competitors, support teams and spectators may capture photographs and video for personal, non-commercial use, provided this does not interfere with the competition, compromise safety or obstruct event operations. This content must not be sold, licensed, supplied to a publication or commercial organisation, used to promote a business or otherwise commercially exploited without Willinga Park's prior written approval.
 - d. Willinga Park may direct any person undertaking unauthorised photography or filming to immediately cease and, where appropriate, leave the event.
- 9 Electrical Leads – All leads from trucks to Willinga Park power outlets must have been tagged within the previous 12 months. An electrician will be on-site to check and tag leads at \$10/lead.
- 10 Allocation of Stables and Camping Sites – Trucks and floats will be allocated stables and camping sites, the OC will send your camping site and stable allocation in the week prior to the competition start.
- 11 Electric Scooters – are allowed but helmets **MUST be worn at all times** and scooters **MUST be parked in the designated scooter parking areas**. Scooters not parked in the designated areas will be removed by Willinga Park staff and will not be available for collection until the end of the event.

NOMINATION CONDITIONS

- 1 **This event is run under EA/FEI rules & regulations.** Including the following:
 - a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
 - b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
 - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
 - d. EA Code of Conduct
 - e. Australian Helmet Standards
 - f. Age Rules including Junior and Young Rider
 - g. Amateur Rules
- 2 All riders competing at the event will be **deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry**, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
- 3 After **any fall** anywhere at Willinga Park, the rider must present to the Medical Services Provider to be cleared BEFORE re-mounting.
- 4 The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion.
- 5 The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- 6 All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.
- 7 **Draw Order – Ring One with no exceptions at any stage will follow draw order.** Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons (for example; loss of shoe) the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this. This event will be Live Streamed – therefore following the correct draw order is of the utmost importance.
- 8 All riders must be current financial full (includes Junior Classes) or participant members of EA.
- 9 For any Young Horse Class an EA Jumping License must be purchased and the age rule of DOB of the horse will apply.
- 10 **Number of Starts:**
 - a. A Horse is only allowed to enter **ONE Spectacular Class**
 - b. **There will be only 1 start for Ring 1 horses on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday**
 - c. Where there are concurrent classes (as in an (a) and (b) section, a horse can only start in one section).
 - d. A rider may start in both sections of a concurrent class – but on different horses.
 - e. Where there are adult and junior class divisions – a rider, if they are according to EA definitions, a Junior, must start in the Junior section.
- 11 Any person competing in a class, must have a registration in that class either via Global Entries Online – or as a change of rider via the Office.
- 12 The OC reserves the right to swab horses.
- 12 **Refunds** – Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$60 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate for class entries only.

NOMINATION CONDITIONS - cont

14 Entry Changes:

a. Are allowed at no charge via Live Editing (Live Editing will open once the show starts from 8am to 3pm)

b. Will incur a \$10 fee if made outside Live Editing hours and must be made at the office.

15 Incorrect Entries – if an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$25/incorrect entry will be incurred. This includes incorrect horse/rider combinations and will be charged at a rate of \$25 per combination per entry.

16 Presentation of Prizes

a. Ring 1 will always be mounted and riders are expected to wear their jackets.

b. Presentations in Ring 2 will be at the direction of the OC.

c. Presentations for Thursday & Friday classes will be held in the Bunker Café Courtyard after the conclusion of classes on Friday.

17 Dress – Formal dress rules apply. Riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the direction of the OC.

18 Maximum number of starts per rider in a class – No rider will be permitted more than three (3) entries in a class.

19 Dogs & Prams & Children

a. Dogs must be on a lead at all times

b. Dogs are not allowed:

i. In the warm-up arena

ii. Walking the course

iii. In the Covered Arena (Warm Up for Ring 2) at any stage – including passing through

c. Prams are not allowed:

i. In the warm-up arena

ii. Walking the course

d. Children under 12 years are not allowed in the warm-up unless mounted on a horse and a competitor in the class in progress.

20 Protests – Must be addressed to the Ground Jury in writing and accompanied by a \$200 fee and can be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the relevant class.

21 Young Horse Boot Rule – For any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, the YH Boot Rule will apply – includes Futurity Classes.

22 GST – is included in all fees and charges, and prize money.

23 Prize money – will be paid through Global Entries Online, please upload your banking details into your Global Profile.

24 Spectacular Classes – Horses are only allowed to be entered into **one Spectacular Class**.

25 Daily Start Times – Will be stated on Equipe once numbers are known. Usually Course Walk 7.30am for FHOC 8am.

26 Article 275 – EA Futurity, Stars of the Future and Future Stars classes

3. For Horses that are 6yrs, 7yrs or 8yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition, there is no point restriction.

27 For World Cup Qualifier Riders:

Please check the current Australian WC Rules on the EA website so you are familiar with what you need to do – but below are some of the main points:

- If you have 2 horses in the WCQ, the horse nominated for WC points must be declared to the PGJ before the start of the competition – at the Horse Inspection (Trot Up)
- If you have 2 horses – the nominated horse must be ridden first in both rounds.
- Bridle numbers must be displayed at all times the horse is not in its stable
- WC horses must be stabled on Friday 11 September
- WC horses must have their stable marked with contacts – the OC will supply the form to be attached to your stable
- Horses must **complete** a competition of 1.30m or above at the 2026 Jumping@Willinga show. (There are several to choose from!)
- The Person Responsible must download the FEI Horse Health App and follow the instructions regarding temperature checking
- Vet Arrival check will be between 8am and 10am on Saturday 12 September
- Horse Inspection will be from 11am on Saturday, 12 September in the Grand Prix Arena.
- Any representations required will be at 1pm, Saturday 12 September
- All clear rounds or the top 12 placed will be invited back for the second round
