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WHAT TO EXPECT

Thinking of working in the Netherlands? Here are some interesting facts to consider!

ONE OF THE TOP BEST PAYING COUNTRIES IN THE WORLD!

According to the <u>Centraal Planbureau</u> (<u>CPB</u>), in 2023 the median gross income for a person working in the Netherlands is 38,500 euros gross per annum. A salary can vary greatly from the median income as it is influenced by age, sector, professional experience and hours worked.

Minimum wage by hour, per week in euros from January 1, 2023 (gross)

HIGHLY SKILLED MIGRANT SALARIES ARE DEPENDENT ON AGE

This might seem surprising but the minimum wage in the Netherlands actually varies based on your age. This also affects your salary requirements for as a highly skilled migrant. The salary thresholds for Highly Skilled Migrants in the Netherlands for 2021 are as follows:

Highly Skilled Migrants 30 years or older: € 5.008 Highly Skilled Migrants younger than 30 years: € 3.672

Note: these are gross monthly amounts (excluding 8% holiday allowance)

WHAT IS THE 30% RULING?

Essentially, as a highly skilled migrant that meets the <u>min requirements</u> you receive a tax exemption on 30% of your salary - you'll only be paying Tax on 70% of your gross salary! You only benefit from this for the first 5 years so make them count.

You and your partner can also exchange your SA drivers licence for a Dutch one (which is valid for 10 years) without having to take the driver's test!

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN NL SALARY

Holiday bonus (Vakantiegeld)

Between May and June you'll receive a lump sum of approximately 8% of your gross salary, just in time for Summer Holidays! This might also be distributed over the year and paid out monthly with your salary.

• 13th Month

As with any job you might receive a bonus. In NL some companies offer what is called the "13th month" which is essentially an extra month's pay It's usually paid between Nov and Dec and equals to roughly 8.33% of your salary. Christmas shopping here we come!

Work Hours

Although 40hr work weeks are common in the Netherlands, some companies make use of a 36hr work week! This allows for better work-life balance which the Netherlands is renowned for.







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
