Radio Radio House Rules

By entering the premises you agree to the following guidelines:

- No entry under the age of 18, identification can be asked.
- Directions from the Radio Radio staff need to be followed.
- By entering the premises you agree to a body search.
- Jackets and bags need to be put in the lockers. Radio Radio is not responsible for lost items, theft or damage.
- Guests that are visibly intoxicated can be refused entry.
- Guests that behave aggressively in any way can be refused entry.
- We expect all our guests to have a tolerant attitude towards the other guests. Radio Radio is a safe space, regardless of gender, race, culture or gender identity.
- Behaviour that is perceived by other guests as aggressive, intimidating or threatening can be followed by removal of the premises. Entry in the future will be refused.
- The staff is here to help you. If you or another guest don't feel well, please come to us.
- In case of an incident like aggressive behaviour or other problems we ask you to warn our staff.
- Radio Radio has the right to refuse groups.
- In case of a crime or misbehaviour the police will be contacted.
- The use or dealing in drugs will result in removal of the premises. In the case of possession of more than the legal amount the police will be contacted.
- Weapons of any kind are not allowed and when found will be confiscated. Entry into the premises will be refused.
- Radio Radio is not responsible for any kind of personal of material damage when on the premises. This also includes hearing damage. Earplugs can be purchased at the bar.
- Your stay at Radio Radio is entirely at your own risk.
- Guests who behave loudly, destructively, leave trash or urinate in public will be removed from the premises and denied entry in the future.
