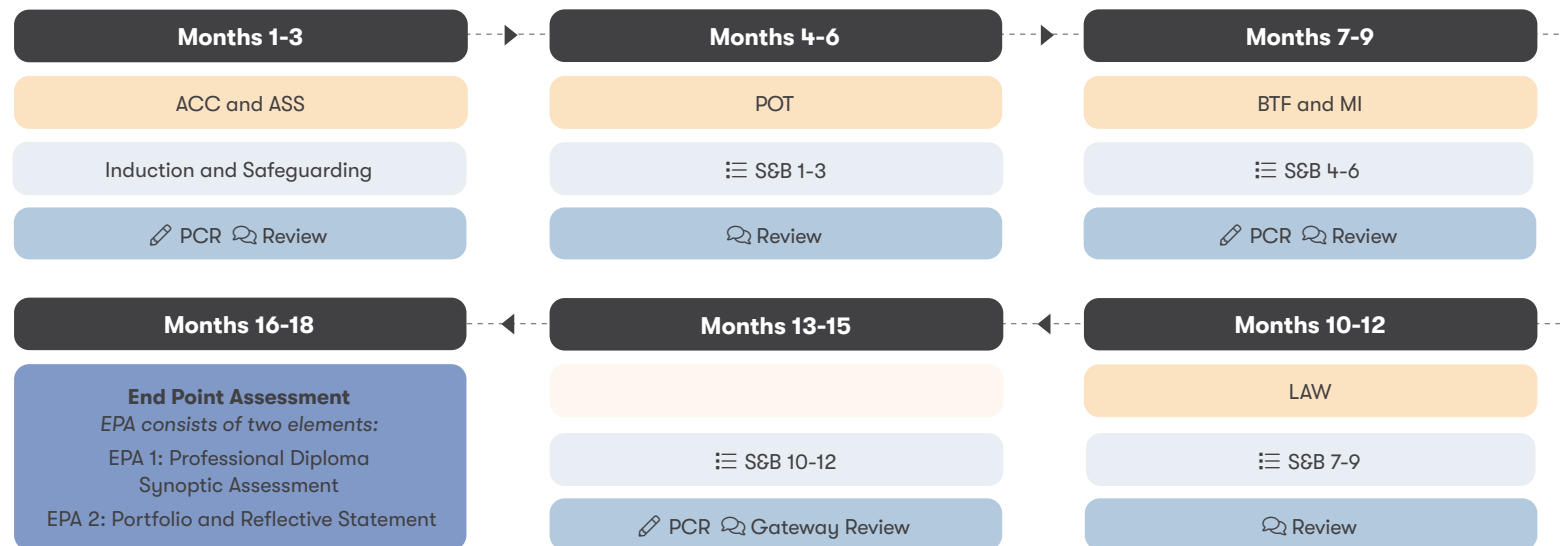


Level 4 Professional Accounting/Tax Technician

To apply for this programme you must be employed in a relevant role, entry requirements are set by individual employers but typically would include five GCSEs.
