Getting Started

Just like the books, these activities were designed to make French feel fun and achievable for children. The activities can be flexibly adjusted to suit your child's attention span, interests and energy level. Here are some tips to help you get started:

- Encourage your child to use the Set 1 books and online audio while working on the activities. The relevant books are shown at the bottom of each sheet.
- Many activities are independent, but partner activities are included to encourage reading and speaking success. Partner activities have the symbol: 🙂 😊





- The icon will remind you of a simple grammar point that your child will use in the activity.
- If you do not have a background in French, it is OK to use English or any other language to guide your child through the activities.
- Most activities require a few basic supplies: a pencil, children's scissors and 10 coloring pencils or crayons matching the colors in *Fou de couleurs* (red, yellow, orange, blue, green, purple, pink, brown, white and black).
- Some activities require additional supplies, such as craft sticks, toys and a bag/hat. (Children should be supervised when using scissors and playing with small objects.)






Supplies: 10 coloring pencils (colors from Fou de couleurs)


- Color each shape a different color. Name the colors and shapes.






Supplies: 10 small items such as cotton balls, blocks or buttons. (Supervise young children.)

- 1. Place one item on each finger below (or draw an outline of your own hands on a piece of paper).
- **2.** Remove one item. How many are left? Now remove two items. How many are left?
- **3.** Now return one item. How many do you have? Now return another item. How many do you have?
- 4. Say Vite vite, encore s'il te plaît! (Quick quick, again please!) and play again, removing and then returning any number of items.



Challenge option: To review colors, use 10 crayons. Example: Je vois huit couleurs. Je ne vois pas de rouge. Je ne vois pas de bleu.

Qu'est-ce que c'est?







Supplies: Draw the 10 animals in *Abracadabra!*

- 1. Place all 10 animals in your bag or hat.
- **2.** Player 1 picks one animal and pretends to be that animal. Move, dance and make animal sounds, but don't say the name out loud!
- **3.** Player 2 guesses the animal by saying, **C'est un/une** _____.
- **4.** Player 1 says **Oui, c'est un/une** ______. or **Non, ce n'est pas** un/une _____. until Player 2 has guessed correctly.
- **5.** Switch positions. Continue until all have finished the 10 animals.



Challenge option: Set the timer to increase the challenge! Write the names of the animals if you can!

Supplies: Draw fruits and snacks from the books. Set the cards or pictures out as if they were in your market, and add prices. You're open for business!

In this partner script, the customer greets the shop cashier and buys snacks and fruit from the **marché** (market).

Customer: Bonjour madame/mademoiselle/monsieur. J'ai quatre fraises, deux petits gâteaux, trois poires et une pastèque.

Cashier: Bonjour! <u>Quatre fraises</u>, <u>trois dollars</u>. <u>Deux petits</u> gâteaux, <u>deux dollars</u>. <u>Trois poires</u>, <u>un dollar</u>. <u>Une pastèque</u>, <u>quatre dollars</u>. C'est dix dollars.

Customer *(paying)*: Très délicieux! C'est l'heure de manger. J'aime manger!

Cashier: Ah oui! Moi aussi, j'aime manger! Merci et bonne journée!

Translation:

Customer: Hello ma'am/miss/sir. Good day! I have <u>four strawberries</u>, <u>two cookies</u>, <u>three pears</u> and <u>one watermelon</u>.

Cashier: Good day! Four strawberries, \$3 dollars. Two cookies, \$2 dollars. Three pears, \$1 dollar. One watermelon, \$4 dollars. That's \$10 dollars.

Customer *(paying)*: How delicious. It's time to eat. I love to eat! **Cashier:** Oh yes! I like to eat. Thank you and have a good day!


Photo 1: Draw cheveux rigolos.




