DIRECTIONS

Shake can well before each spray. Flip straw up for pinpoint stream or down for wide angle spray. All surfaces to be cleaned should be cool. Protect any sensitive electrical or electronic components and engine intakes. Shake well and spray onto surface to be cleaned. Let sit for at least 1 minute, then use a brush to break up heavy deposits of grease and dirt. Wipe with a dry cloth and/or rinse with water.

STORAGE

Store in a cool, well-ventilated area, away from incompatible materials. Do not store above 120°F or in direct sunlight. U.F.C (NFPA 30B) Level 3 Aerosol. Store away from oxidizers.
