DIRECTIONS

Shake can well before each spray. All surfaces to be cleaned should be cool. Protect any sensitive electrical or electronic components and engine intakes. Point nozzle toward mark. Spray liberally on area to be degreased. Allow to penetrate for several minutes. Use a brush to break up heavy deposits of grease and dirt. Wipe with a dry cloth and/or rinse with water. Do not spray on running engines. Do not contact battery terminals or starter solenoid with can. To drive out moisture and protect equipment after cleaning, spray liberally with WD-40® Multi-Use Product.

STORAGE
