Non-abrasive, non-corrosive, residue-free and containing no harmful fumes, Food-Processing Facility Degreaser & Cleaner EZ-Pods are safe to use on multiple surfaces, including most metals, plastics, rubbers, neoprene, stainless steel, and carbon fiber (when used as directed). For tough, caked-on grease and dirt, allow solution to set for a few minutes, then wipe off or rinse with water. For use in food-processing facilities, rinse with potable water. Repeat if necessary.

DIRECTIONS

NO FOOD CONTACT - Protect or remove food from area before use. Add water to a clean container of choice, then drop in 1 to 2 liquid pod(s) per 32 fl oz of water. EZ-Pods dissolve faster in warm water. Wait at least 1 minute for pod(s) to begin dissolving. Shake or stir until pod(s) completely dissolve. Spray onto surface to be degreased or cleaned, then rinse with potable water. For tough, caked-on grease and dirt, allow solution to set for a few minutes. Repeat if necessary.
