In addition to this, in view of the increased demands from the market for VUN products, Alha's management has certified its main facilities and vehicles according to TAPA (Transported Asset Protection Association) standards, in order to achieve excellence in the logistics of high value products.

The ALHA Group is committed to operate in line with the following principles:

- Sharing of Security Policy guidelines with all staff (awareness)
- Focus on training in terms of development, growth and enhancement of the quality and competitiveness of Security staff, with periodic updates
- Application of the corporate code of ethics
- Qualification of its service providers, first and foremost handling service companies and transport subcontractors
- Integration of security procedures into the company management system
- Monitoring of events and CAPA approach in response to them
- Full control and maintenance of its security equipment

It is the task of the Heads of Function:
