Methodologies

This disclosure details all transfers of value made to Healthcare Professionals and Healthcare organisations in the UK and Ireland by Pharmacosmos UK and includes payments made by Pharmacosmos A/S (Global), Pharmacosmos Affiliates and Partner Companies, where another UK entity is not making the disclosure. All payments disclosed were made in 2025.

HCPs were chosen regardless of whether or not consent to disclose was provided. Where consent to disclose was not provided or not received, these amounts have been included as an aggregate amount. For each HCP consent was obtained once for all activity and not for individual activities. Any consent from HCPs to disclose transfers of value at an individual level that was received after the deadline of 24/04/2026 could not be accommodated. Hence, such values remain included within the aggregate figure, rather than disclosed at an individual level.

Payments to HCOs have been disclosed on an activity basis.

Payments to Members of the Public have been disclosed in an anonymised aggregate figure.

All disclosed data is in GBP. Where payments were converted from another currency, the calculations reflect the actual exchange rate on the date the payment was made. All amounts are inclusive of VAT where VAT has been paid.

The information declared includes transfers of value that were made and does not include any planned activities and transfers where HCPs did not for whatever reason complete.
