Job Description

The Fair Farm Animal Attendant will provide friendly customer service by greeting patrons, monitoring safety of guests and animals in petting area, answering questions, directing people to hand washing station, scooping animal waste, and monitoring entrances and exits.

Job Requirements:

- Display a sense of ease while speaking with the public one on one
- Work with adults and children of all ages, but primarily ages 3-9
- Candidates must be able to stand on feet for long periods of time while standing or walking through the exhibit
- Some light lifting up to 30 lbs. is required
- Be able to withstand wood chip dust in the petting area
- Be flexible to a fast-paced environment with high energy and moderate level of noise.
- Must submit to background check and be 18 years or older.
