Job Description

Attendants are needed for a variety of exhibits and attractions, including themed experiences, interactive displays, and family-focused areas across the Fairgrounds. Responsibilities include greeting and interacting with guests, providing information about exhibits and interactive elements, assisting with crowd control and line management, monitoring exhibit spaces to ensure guest safety and display integrity, and performing light cleaning tasks such as wiping surfaces, restocking materials, and tidying attraction areas. Attendants must be comfortable standing and walking for up to eight hours at a time, working both indoors and outdoors in a fast-paced environment. Ideal candidates are friendly, attentive, and reliable, with strong communication skills and a commitment to guest service. Shifts may include weekends, evenings, and holidays during the Fair season. This job is a seasonal, non-benefitted position with a wage range of \$16.66 to \$16.66/hr.

Job Requirements

- Work with guests of all ages.
- Display a sense of ease while speaking with the public one on one.
- Be able to stand on feet for long periods while standing or walking through the exhibit.
- Some light lifting up to 20 lbs. may be required.
- Be flexible to a fast-paced environment with high energy and moderate level of noise.
