Job Description

The Washington State Fair is hiring **Tractor Tracks Attendants** for our outdoor children's pedal tractor attraction. This role is responsible for maintaining a safe and orderly environment by monitoring entrance and exit points, ensuring proper helmet use, redirecting traffic flow, supervising the course for safe play, and light lifting of metal pedal tractors throughout the shift.

Attendants must be able to greet guests, answer basic questions, and maintain a friendly and professional demeanor in a fast-paced setting. This position requires standing for long periods and working outdoors in all weather conditions. Shifts may include weekends, evenings, and holidays. This job is a seasonal, non-benefitted position with a wage range of \$16.66 to \$16.66/hr.

Job Requirements

- Work with children of all ages, but primarily ages 3-9
- Display a sense of ease while speaking with the public one on one.
- Be able to stand on feet for long periods while standing or walking through the exhibit. Some light lifting up to 20 lbs. is required.
- Be able to work in all weather conditions both inside and outside.
- Be flexible to a fast-paced environment with high energy and moderate level of noise.
