This position is responsible for evening and night-time operations within the Spring Fair barns. Duties include closing and monitoring barns after public hours and ensuring the safety and welfare of animals and equipment.

Animal care responsibilities include keeping stalls clean, monitoring animals for signs of distress, and promptly notifying the Barn Superintendent of any urgent concerns. Barn-related duties include assisting with hay delivery, maintaining clean hay storage areas, moving dumpsters into barns for morning chores, and safeguarding equipment.

This job is a seasonal, non-benefitted position with a wage range of \$17.13 - \$17.13/hr.
