## **EYEDROPS:**

We recommend compounded 3-in-1 eyedrops that combine three medicines into one convenient bottle. These are purchased in our office and provided to you to begin after your surgery.

If you select prescription eyedrops, we will prescribe three bottles per eye. We recommend Brand eyedrops over generic eyedrops. To minimize cost of Brand eyedrops, we utilize Apothecary Pharmacy. Apothecary will contact you via text message and can deliver to your home address. Brand eyedrops through your local pharmacy can be expensive, despite insurance coverage. Generic eye drops are typically sent to your local pharmacy. Please fill the brand or generic prescriptions a few days prior to surgery, and start using them one day before surgery

## FASTING:

Do not eat or drink anything after 12 AM midnight the day before your surgery day. This is a requirement by the anesthesia department.

#### **MEDICATIONS:**

You may take your medications with a sip of water (not juice, coffee or milk) on the morning of surgery. If you are diabetic, call your medical doctor regarding adjusting diabetes medicine. Please ask your medical doctor, if you need to adjust other medications before or after the surgery. Dr. Raviv does not require that you stop aspirin, Coumadin, Plavix or other blood thinners for cataract surgery.

## **ESCORT HOME:**

Someone must pick you up after surgery; this is a NY State regulation. A medical escort can be hired if needed.

### POST OP VISIT:

You are scheduled for a postop visit at 30 East 60<sup>th</sup> Street, ste 2002 office on On your post-op visit, you will be seeing Dr.
