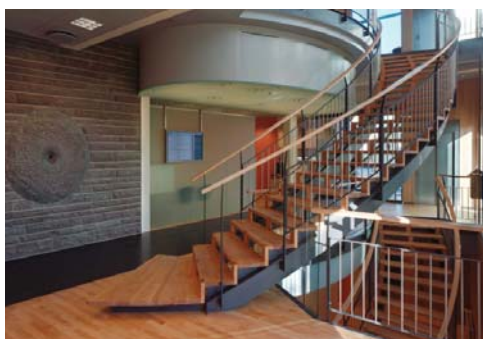


Icelandic Parliament-Service Building

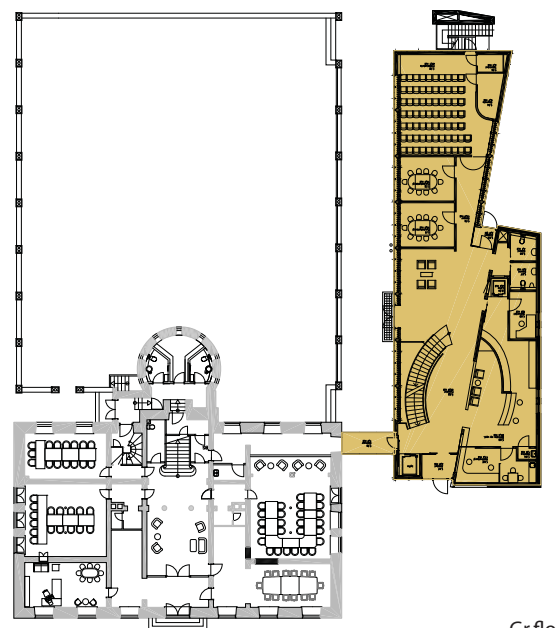




Icelandic Parliament-Service Building
