

IMPORTANCE TO NEW ZEALAND'S FUTURE

31 percent of New Zealanders see Viet Nam as important to New Zealand's future.

FRIEND PERCEPTIONS

49 percent of New Zealanders identify Viet Nam as a friend or close friend, up eight percentage points from the last survey.

Only **two percent** of New Zealanders see Viet Nam as a threat.

HOW HAVE PERCEPTIONS CHANGED SINCE 2019?

Sentiment towards Viet Nam has grown considerably since 2019. While **32 percent** of New Zealanders saw Viet Nam as a friend in 2019, **49 percent** of New Zealanders view it as a friend today.
