In partnership with Samantha & Neil Perry of Double Bay's Margaret Precinct and Linden Pride and Nathalie Hudson of the renowned Dante NYC, Bobbie's is a tribute to the Australian hall-of-fame disc jockey, Bob Rogers and a life lived during the golden age of Rock n Roll. A time of big ideas, three-martini lunches and larger than life personalities. With a focus on Australian produce, ice cold martinis and a deep sense of hospitality, Bobbie's is a place for great music, coming together and celebrating life.



WHO IS BOBBIE?

Bob Rogers, born in 1926, was a trailblazer in Australian radio, leaving an indelible mark on the industry. Beginning his career at just 16 as a panel operator at 3XY in Melbourne, he revolutionized radio in 1958 with the launch of Australia's first Top 40 show on 2UE. This groundbreaking move transformed the way music was broadcast and influenced the listening habits of a generation.

Known for his infectious energy and warm presence, Rogers became a beloved figure in Australian media. He further solidified his influence with "The Bob Rogers Show" on Channel Seven. In 2010, he was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia for his significant contributions to the industry, particularly in promoting Australian music and new talent. His legacy as a radio pioneer highlights the power of media to connect, entertain, and inspire.

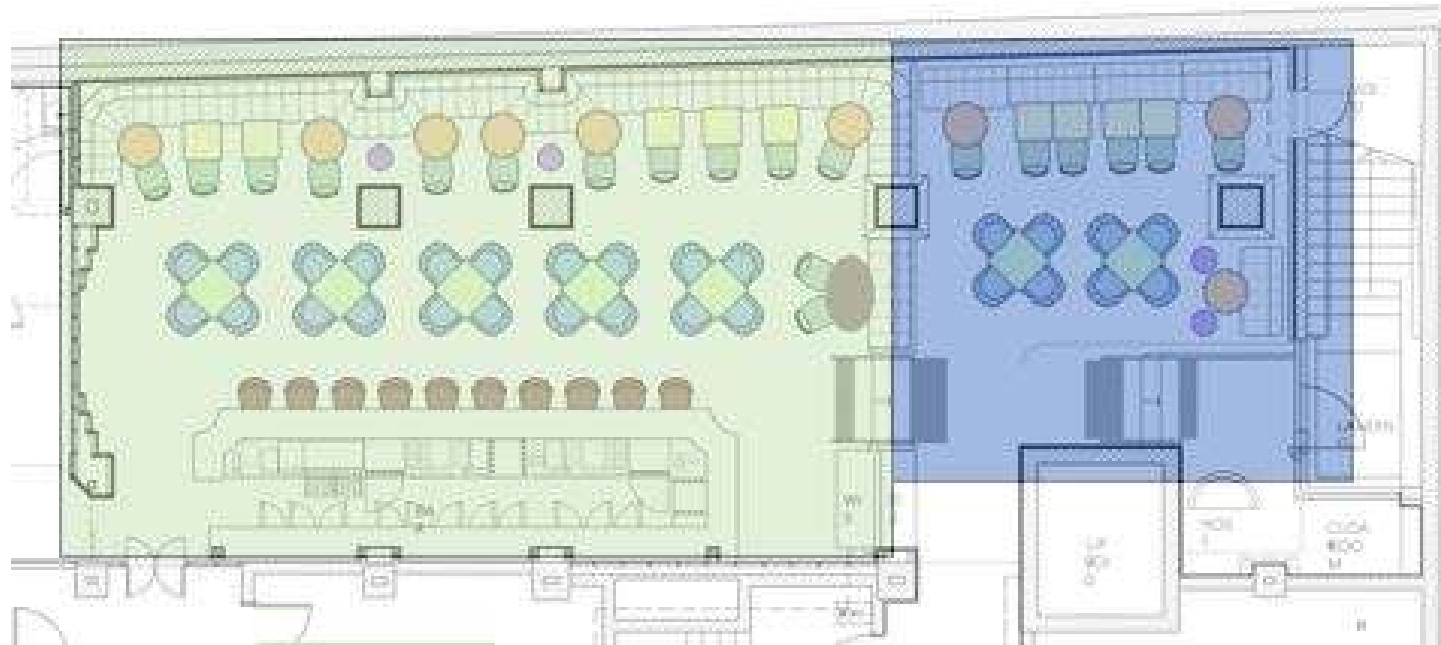

DESIGN & SPACE

Bobbie's layout is long, and stepped, which intentionally builds a sense of discovery and intimacy as you enter and move further into the space. The main bar is elegantly arranged with plush velvet chairs, marble topped tables, and a mint green banquette that wraps around the perimeter of the main bar pit, creating an array of intimate, beautifully lit nooks where guests can huddle. A stepped archway in a bronzed mirror at the end of the main room finishes the space and establishes a performance area for live acts, or indeed dancing.



“Big band jazz was always played at my parents’ dinners and gatherings. I’m very thankful that music, dancing and conversation were encouraged in my upbringing, and that I could bring this energy to the drawings at Bobbie’s.

It was a delight to take on the Bobbie’s mural project and work with Caon Design Office. We spent time working out an approach for the wall vignettes which would focus on expressing joyful and curious story telling in keeping with the rich background of Bob Rogers.

To develop the work, I drew from the culture of American music, films and nightlife, Pierre Bonnard, Picasso’s drawings, and the perspectives of photographer Saul Leiter. Late 50’s/ early 60’s films like Paris Blues and The Sweet Smell of Success offered a wealth of imagery too... there was a rawness to the way people were connecting with each other and absorbing art and creativity at the time.

I have lived and worked in San Francisco, Sydney, and London, and currently in Melbourne, where I continue to work predominantly in film and theatre alongside my own art practice.”
