The Facts



Nearly **three in four Veteran suicides** (73.5%) involve firearms



47% of suicides among children and adolescents involve firearms



Most individuals who lack easy access to lethal means will **not die by suicide**

AFSP Recommendations

- Help Veterans access secure firearm storage devices to protect themselves and their families
- Educate Veterans and health care providers who work with Veterans about the importance of lethal means safety, including secure firearm storage
- Support the Department of Veterans Affairs' efforts to prevent firearm suicide

- **S.926** is led by Senator Angus King (ME) and Senator Tim Sheehy (MT); it is in the Senate Veterans' Affairs Committee
- This bipartisan bill will direct the Department of Veterans Affairs to:
 - Provide secure firearm storage devices to any
 Veteran upon request, free of charge
 - Develop and publish information on secure firearm storage, including a public awareness campaign to promote secure storage among
 Veterans and their families
- Less than a third of firearm owners store firearms in a secure manner
- A majority of deaths by suicide involve firearms, and nearly 90% of firearm suicides among children and youth involve a firearm stored in an unsecure manner in the home

Secure firearm storage gives time for suicidal crises to pass and protects firearm owners and their families.
