# Boulder Care is a digital clinic offering long-term support and telehealth treatment for substance use.

At least 1 in 8 workers has an untreated substance use disorder (SUD), costing employers nearly \$200 billion annually. The rate of overdose among people with large employer coverage has increased over nine-fold in the last decade, with a 29% increase in overdose deaths in the US in 2020, compared to 2019.

To address the growing need for accessible, affordable SUD treatment, Boulder Care has partnered with health plans including Premera, Regence, Anthem Ohio, and others to provide in-network telehealth addiction treatment.

Through these health plan partnerships, your employees may have access to a dedicated Care Team that they can reach anytime, anywhere via smartphone. Care is delivered through secure video and messaging, and care plans are built around patients' unique recovery goals, empowering them to succeed on their own terms, wherever they are in their journey.


