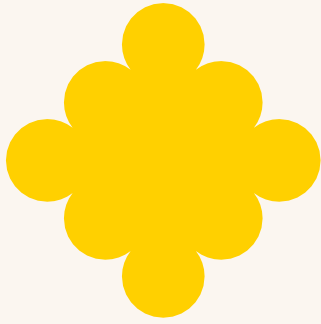




Close-to-Home Care Fund Pediatric Care Spaces

Submit a Grant Application

The Care Environment Fund aims to support the construction, renovation and design of spaces tailored to children and their families, providing improved care settings and comfortable areas that promote recovery. This fund enables the creation of adapted spaces, enhancing medical and clinical practices across regions.

Funded Projects

- Intervention room (screening, assessment, medical care, surgeries, ID-ASD-PD therapies, speech therapy, mental health interventions, etc.)
- Care units (neonatology, pediatrics, intermediate care, intensive care, child psychiatry)
- Tailored spaces (bedroom, bathroom, multisensory room, breastfeeding room)
- Clinical spaces (outpatient clinic, external clinic, vaccination clinic)

Projects selection

Assessment of the impact generated for children, families, and healthcare teams in alignment with Enfant Soleil's mission. Submitted projects will be prioritized according to the following order:

1. Deploy essential new local pediatric care services
2. Enhance and expand the offering of local pediatric care
3. Improve the experience of the child and their family throughout the pediatric care journey

Application Eligibility Criteria

- Be a public health or social services institution located in Quebec.
- Comply with regional child health development policies
- Comply with the establishment's permit (level of care)
- Be dedicated to a pediatric clientele
- Have the human and material resources required for use, maintenance and sustainability

Financial Contribution

The awarded amount may cover up to 100% of the eligible expenses presented. However, please note that the annually available funds and the number of selected projects may influence the final amount granted.

Eligible Expenses (labor and materials)

- Coverings
- Security system
- Lighting
- Paint
- Carpentry
- Electricity
- Plumbing
- Hardware
- Glass partitions
- Soundproof walls
- Furniture (beds, chairs, tables, cabinets)
- Decoration

Exclusions

- Design services for creating plans
- Contingency fees
- Development of living environments or residences with continuous assistance
- Maintenance or repair costs for facilities (e.g., windows, roofing, ventilation)

Steps for Grant Allocation

1. Project approval by your facility's management
2. Submission of an application including all required supporting documents
3. Analysis and recommendation by an external committee of independent experts
4. Approval of the grant by the Board of Directors of Enfant Soleil
5. Approval by Santé Québec (if applicable)
6. Signature of the agreement between Enfant Soleil and the applicant
7. Implementation of a concerted recognition plan adapted to the project
8. Public announcement of the grant by Enfant Soleil
9. Implementation of the project
10. Claim for the granted funds (gradually or in full) upon presentation of invoices
11. Annual accountability must be submitted demonstrating the progress of the project through to its full completion within a maximum period of 30 months.
