



Expert advice for a seamless trip

01



Ensure you bring a credit card

- In order to collect your vehicle you will require a credit card, with the name matching the name of the booked driver. The rental company will require a bond which acts as your insurance. This is refunded to your credit card when the vehicle is dropped off.

02



Make sure your license is in English

- Please ensure your license is written in English. If you have a foreign license please obtain an International Drivers Permit, if in doubt also bring along your passport when collecting your vehicle.

03



Save your receipts


- If your listing includes fuel reimbursements please make sure you save your receipts along the way. Present these to the staff when dropping off your vehicle in order to get your money refunded. Without receipts you will not receive any reimbursement.
