









Agency codes

Agency codes are a unique identifier made up of numbers and letters which relate to the terms of business that you have agreed to with the insurer. Typically, you'll find your agency details with the information you received from the insurer agency team when you first registered for terms of business with them.

Type of agency details needed	How does this look?
 <p>Confirmation of registration</p>	Confirmation you have terms of business; we will obtain agency codes from them.
 <p>Agency code</p>	Code Example: 112257233
 <p>Confirmation of registration based on FRN provided</p>	HSBC do not provide agency codes; confirmation you have terms of business will suffice.
 <p>Agency code</p>	Code Example: 123456A
 <p>Individual Reference number</p>	Code Example: 7XXXXXX NB: Each adviser registered with RL will have its own code
 <p>Agency code</p>	Code Example: A0123456
 <p>Agency code</p>	Code Example: 123456/001
 <p>Agency code</p>	Code Example: PXXXXX
