

XERF PRE-TREATMENT

Hydration

- Drink at least 64 oz of water daily in the 24–48 hours leading up to your appointment.
- Well-hydrated skin responds better to radiofrequency energy and improves your overall comfort during treatment.

Sun Exposure & Skin Health

- Sun exposure can temporarily increase skin dryness and sensitivity.
- Protect your skin with a broad-spectrum SPF 30+ and stay well hydrated in the days leading up to your appointment.
- Your provider will assess your skin on the day of treatment and tailor your treatment accordingly.

Skincare — What to Pause Before Your Appointment

- Discontinue retinoids (Retin-A, tretinoin) 5–7 days before treatment.
- Exception: If you have been on a retinoid for an extended period and your skin is intact with no flaking or sensitivity, you may continue use. When in doubt, ask your provider.
- Stop glycolic acid, salicylic acid, and all other exfoliating products 5–7 days before treatment.

Day of Treatment

- Arrive with a completely clean face — no makeup, lotions, deodorant, or oils on the treatment area.
- If you arrive with product on the skin, your provider will need to cleanse the area fully before treatment can begin.
- Hair-bearing areas should be shaved 1–2 days before treatment.
- Shaving the same day is perfectly fine if needed. This helps the device make proper contact with the skin.

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Medical & Safety Information

- Inform your provider of any metal implants, pacemakers, or defibrillators before treatment.
- Radiofrequency energy is contraindicated with certain implanted devices. Please disclose this information at or before your appointment.
- If you have a history of cold sores (oral or facial herpes), please notify your provider.
- Antiviral medication may be prescribed as a precaution prior to treatment in the facial area.
