In addition, under FOIA where additional time is required to consider the public interest test, an extension is allowed 'until such time as is reasonable in the circumstances' (see section 10(3) FOIA).

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> It is important to note that where we provide information but redact a small amount of information (e.g. someone's name or contact details), this will count as a partial refusal. In addition, where information is already published on our website or where an individual has posed a question which is too broad to answer, this will also count as a refusal, as will requests where we have asked for a name or clarification but not received it.
