

# GETTING STARTED ON BUPRENORPHINE: **Conventional Initiation Method** for New Patients

For Conventional initiation, it is essential that your last use of opioids is 18-72 hours before your first dose of buprenorphine and that you are in severe withdrawal, with at least two of the following signs: large pupils, goosebumps, runny nose & tearing, sweating, vomiting, diarrhea, or yawning.

The longer you can wait before your first dose of buprenorphine after your last use of opioids, the greater likelihood you'll successfully initiate using the Conventional method.

If you use short-acting opioids like Percocet (oxycodone), Vicodin (hydrocodone), heroin, or kratom Stop use 18-24 HOURS before your first dose of buprenorphine.



If you use long-acting opioids or fentanyl Stop use 36-72 HOURS before your first dose of buprenorphine.

After 18-72 hours have elapsed since your last use (depending on the type of opioid) and you are in severe withdrawal, follow these instructions:



Take 2 mg strips or tablets) of buprenorphine, and wait 60-90 minutes.



After 60-90 minutes, take another 2-4 mg strips or tablets) ( of buprenorphine.



**Continue to take 2-4 mg doses** ( strips or tablets) every 60-90 minutes, up to the daily amount prescribed to you by your provider.

**NOTE:** If your withdrawal symptoms get significantly worse after the first 1-2 doses of buprenorphine, reach out to the Nurse Care Team at 1-877-522-1275 to discuss an alternative initiation method.
