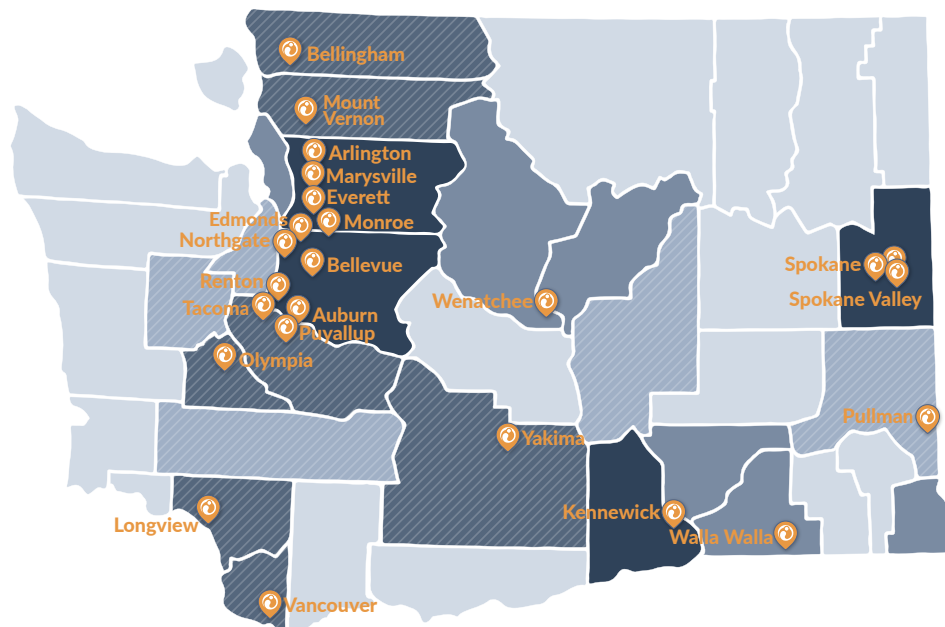

Ideal Option's Treatment Works.

Lab testing results¹ for patients who remained in Ideal Option's treatment program and stayed on their prescribed medications show:

Ideal Option has been providing evidence-based treatment for substance use disorder using FDA-approved medications — the gold standard in addiction treatment — for more than 13 years in Washington.

Self-reported outcomes gathered via survey of over 850 Ideal Option patients after a minimum of six months of treatment show:

95% say NO!



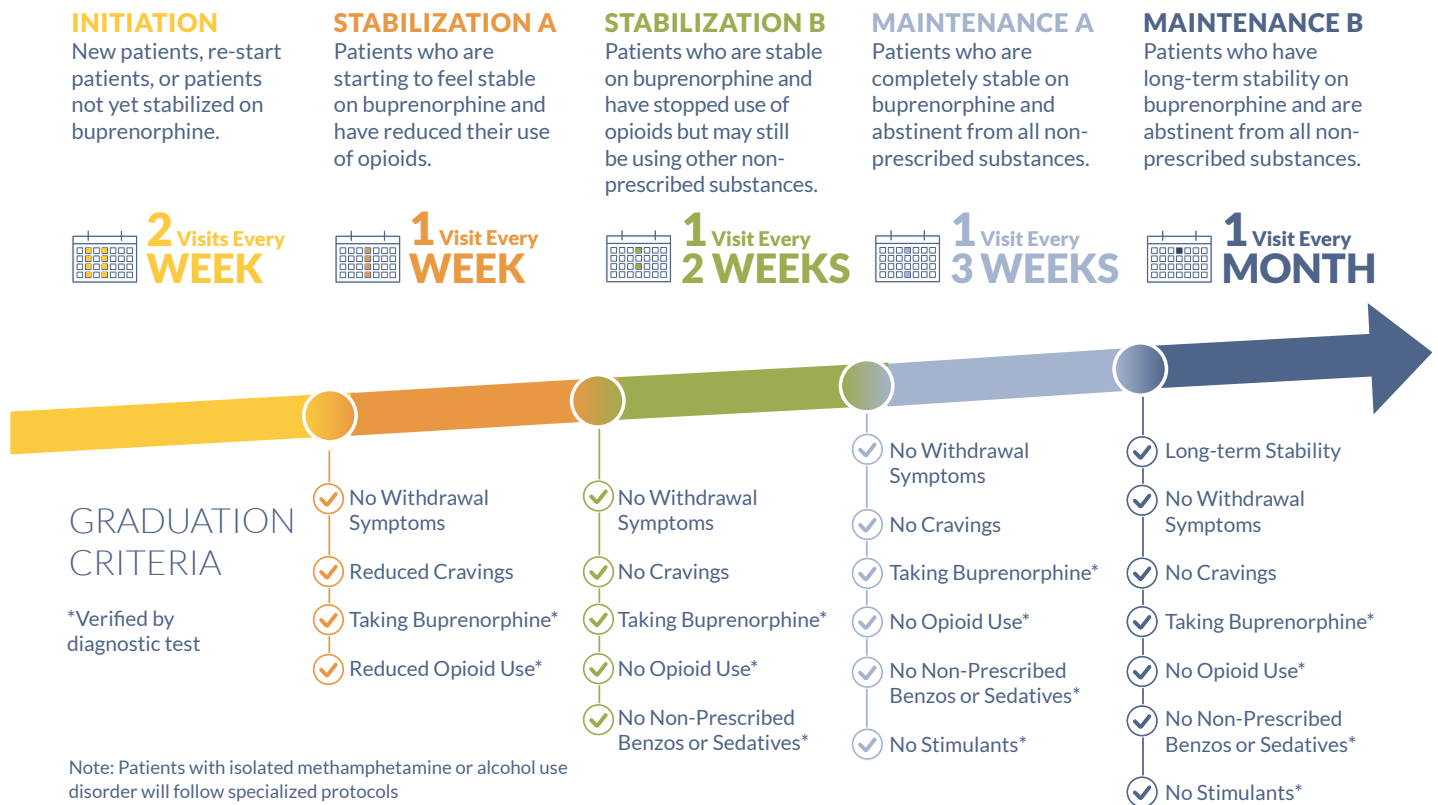

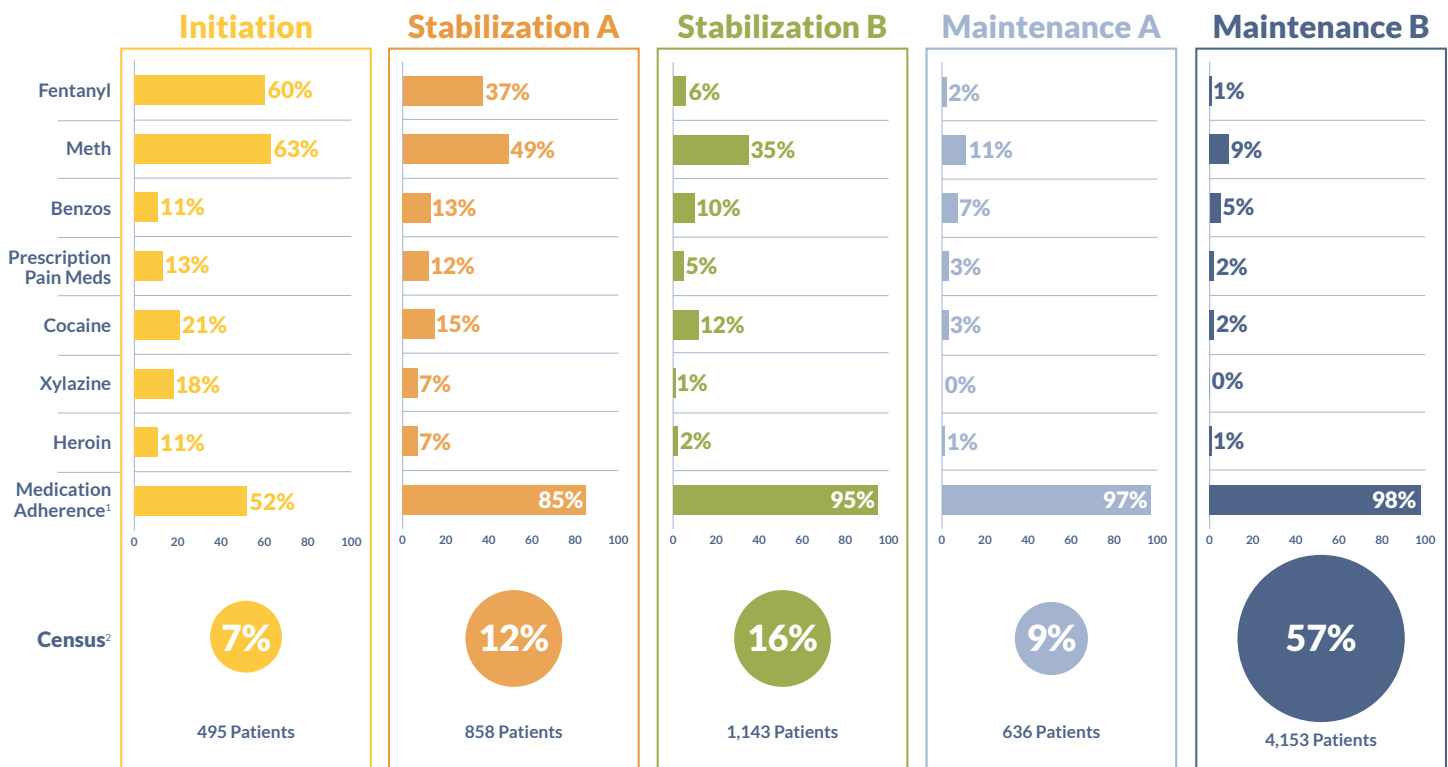
