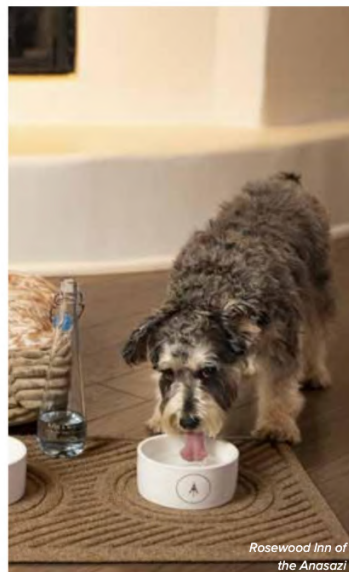

August is National Dog Month and a reminder that, for many of us, our four-legged friends are more than pets—they’re family. With roughly 58 million U.S. households sharing their homes with at least one pup, more travelers are hitting the road with their furry companions, and these New Mexico hotels are raising the bar for pet-friendly travel.

ARRIVE Albuquerque

Set along Route 66 near Old Town, this mid-century-inspired boutique newcomer has clearly given some thought to its four-legged guests. For a one-time \$50 pet cleaning fee, well-behaved dogs up to 30 pounds are welcome and receive a plush bed, ceramic bowls, organic treats, and a custom chew toy on arrival. Dog-friendly Robinson Park sits right across the street, offering a convenient green space for quick outings.

Four Seasons Resort Rancho Encantado Santa Fe

Dogs are treated to plenty of luxuries at Four Seasons Resort Rancho Encantado, but a standout here might just be its hiking trails. Set on 150 acres outside Santa Fe, the resort gives canine guests plenty of space to stretch their legs, with on-property paths winding through piñon- and juniper-covered hillsides. Ground-floor casitas offer particularly easy outdoor access, while plush bedding, freshly filled water bowls, homemade treats, and access to a dedicated “Furry Friends” menu—featuring grilled salmon, chicken breast, and steak served with rice and vegetables—await. “The resort goes above and beyond for their furry friends,” says repeat guest and Dallas resident Kim Cole. During an unexpected three-day extension after her car broke down en route from Arizona to Texas, staff stepped in when she ran out of food for her Vizsla, Rusty. “They pampered him with gourmet

food from the in-room dining menu,” she says. “I also went hiking with him each morning on the Camino Encantado trail. He was living his best life.”

Rosewood Inn of the Anasazi

Steps from Santa Fe Plaza, Rosewood Inn of the Anasazi welcomes up to two pets of any size. Dog owners may want to book a Junior Suite, one of the few room categories with a private outdoor balcony. For a \$75 nightly fee, pets receive a bed, food, and water bowls. For added convenience in the middle of downtown, there’s also a grassy relief area on the property. A short drive away, the Santa Fe Railway is another draw with its parks, walking paths, and several dog-friendly patios.

Hotel Willa

Hotel Willa keeps things refreshingly simple. The stylish Taos stay welcomes up to two dogs with no size or breed restrictions, offers treats on arrival, and invites guests to share a few details about their pet before check-in. Unlike most hotels, dogs are welcome throughout the property—including the restaurant, bar, and outdoor spaces—except for the pool area. Nearby Kit Carson Park makes an easy destination for morning walks, while the trails around the Rio Grande Gorge offer more room to roam. Another perk? Seasonal JSX flights connect Taos with California during the winter months. The semi-private carrier has become a favorite among pet owners because dogs and cats fly in the cabin alongside their people, avoiding the stress of cargo holds and busy airport terminals. Through a partnership with Petco, four-legged passengers also receive complimentary bandanas, cookies, and customized in-flight snacks.

El Monte Sagrado

The welcome amenity at another Taos stand-out, El Monte Sagrado, isn't a treat—it's an entire "barcutterie platter." Included with the resort's HosPETality Package, the arrival spread features roasted squash, a cooked-to-order Wagyu patty, organic blueberries, and organic peanut butter. Up to two dogs are welcome, with the pet fee included and a \$35 charge for a second pet. Beyond the food, six acres of landscaped grounds offer plenty of room for leisurely walks.

Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces

One of the nicest touches at Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces isn't for humans. The hotel's HosPETality Package includes the pet fee along with chef-made dog treats, pet waste bags, and beds and bowls waiting in the room upon arrival. Set on the north side of town beneath the Organ Mountains, it's a short drive to two local favorites: Las Cruces Dog Park at Burn Lake for off-leash playtime and Old Mesilla Plaza for a slow stroll among the adobe buildings and café patios.
