ALL CONFERENCE ACTIVITIES will take place on the "classroom" level of the venue.

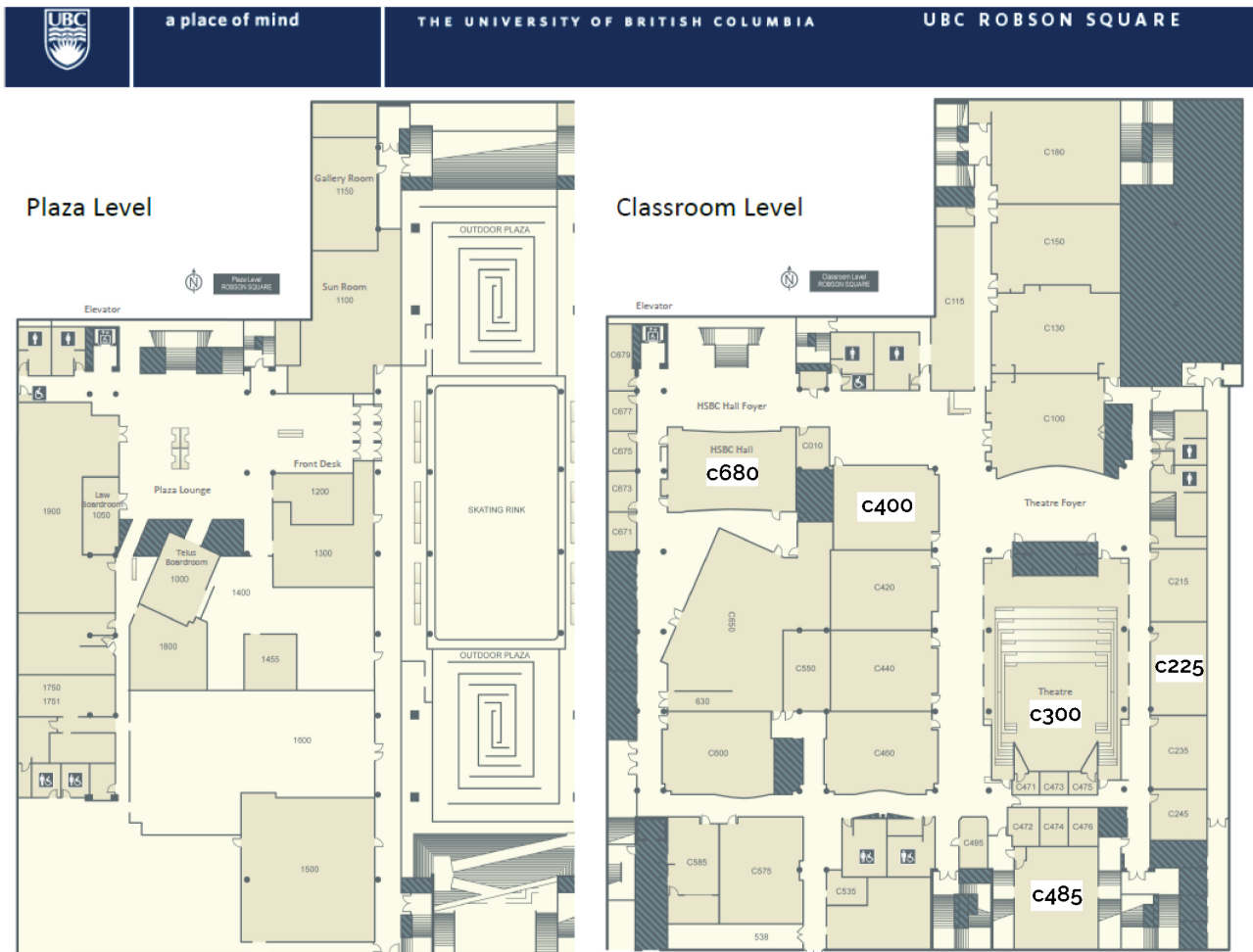
Plenary session will take place in theatre **C300**, and workshops will take place in either Room **C400** or Room **C485**. Please refer to the program for the location of each workshop.
