

Local Government Grant Program Application Questions 2026

Important Submission Instructions:

Each proposed project requires its own separate application. This system is designed to track individual initiatives and their specific management models. For example, if your subdivision plans to run one internal project and two projects through external partners, you must submit three (3) distinct applications. This process ensures that every project receives a dedicated technical review, a specific legal contract, and its own tailored performance tracking plan.

Section 1: Project Identity & Alignment

2. **Primary Purpose: Provide a concise description of your project and what it intends to achieve. (Limit: 200 words)**
3. **Target Population: Define who this project will serve (e.g., specific demographic, geographic area, or vulnerable group). (Limit: 200 words)**
4. **Allowable Use Selection: Select the applicable category and subcategory from the Delaware Opioid Abatement and Remediation Strategies (OARS) list.**

5. **Leadership Team:** Identify the key personnel responsible for project oversight, fiscal management, and day-to-day operations. (Limit: 100 words)
6. **Collaboration & Partnerships:** List any key stakeholders (non-profits, health systems, or other government agencies) essential to this project's success. Describe their specific roles, responsibilities, and any planned allocation of grant funds. (Limit: 200 words)

Section 3: Budget & Sustainability
