EDUCATION


We provide longer-term educational programs to the next generation of city builders, planners, and urban leaders.



Capstone Project

Placement in a real-world organization.

As part of the Capstone Project, participants will take part in short monthly online workshops to ensure core technical skills needed to complete the Capstone.

Who can apply?

The diploma is oriented towards early- and mid-career professionals (2-4 years of professional experience). However, we encourage all applicants passionate about urban development and African cities apply.

Applications are open for the 2025 - 2026 Cohort.

Program Fees

Price for the full professional diploma: \$4,500 USD

Price for an individual course: \$1,500 USD

Scholarships are awarded based on merit and need. Scholarships will only be available for those applying for the full Professional Diploma.

Admission to this program is based on merit. The application process requires submission of an updated CV, a persuasive cover letter or essay, and an academic or professional reference. Upon reviewing the application, the admissions team will reach out to all applicants with the final results. Participants receive a certificate for each completed module within the diploma and a full diploma degree upon completion of all the modules.

Cohort 2025-2026

Capstone

The AUL is focused on equipping students with applicable skills by challenging them with real-world problems. The Capstone Project is a professional immersion program that allows participants to put the knowledge they've learned in the classroom into practice.

Student groups are embedded within relevant organizations and tasked with leading a substantive urban development project. The AUL team matches students with a Capstone Project that aligns with their capacities and professional aspirations. The duration of the placement is five months. During this time, students also participate in technical workshops led by AUL staff to help them build the skills needed to complete their Capstone Project.

Capstone Goals

- 1. Build the participant's technical and interpersonal capacity to lead urban development projects on the continent.
- 2. Build a network of knowledge exchange between participants completing Capstone Projects, government agencies focused on urbanization, private sector actors working on urban development, and urban labs across the continent (including the AUL).
 - 3. Develop real-world urban development expertise.

Scholarships

The Africa Urban Lab is committed to ensuring our academic programs are accessible to all high-achieving applicants, regardless of income level or socioeconomic background. This dedication enriches the learning environment, promotes accessibility, and bolsters academic excellence. All scholarships awarded by the AUL will be based on both merit and need. Scholarships are available exclusively for the full professional diploma program. Individuals enrolling in standalone courses are required to cover the costs themselves.

There is no separate application process for scholarships. Once you submit your diploma application, the AUL staff will assess your eligibility for a scholarship.

MAARIFA SCHOLARSHIP (African scholars)	This scholarship is dedicated to early-career professionals normally residing in Africa who work in both private and public African institutions and demonstrate excellence, leadership, and unique talents. This scholarship will cover tuition fees, airfare, and accommodation.
MASHARIKI SCHOLARSHIPS (East African Scholars)	This scholarship is dedicated to early-career professionals normally residing in East Africa who work in both private and public institutions and demonstrate excellence, leadership, and unique talents. This scholarship will cover tuition fees, airfare, and accommodation.
ZANZIBAR SCHOLARSHIPS	In cooperation with local governmental and non-governmental institutions in Zanzibar, AUL offers scholarships to outstanding early-career professionals who are normally residing in Zanzibar and work in public or private Zanzibari institutions. Candidates must be nominated by their respective institutions to qualify for this scholarship. This scholarship will cover tuition fees.
MAFUNZO SCHOLARSHIPS (Tuition only scholarships)	The Mafunzo scholarship is dedicated to excellent early-career professionals normally residing in Africa and working in African and non-African institutions. This scholarship will cover tuition fees only.
MAISHA SCHOLARSHIPS (Partial living expenses and tuition scholarships)	The Maisha scholarship is dedicated to excellent early-career professionals normally residing in Africa and working in African and non-African institutions. This scholarship will cover 30% to 70% of the total tuition fees and

living expenses.
