

## Hiking from the Plan de l'Aiguille


Traverse Plan de l'Aiguille-Montenvers: one of Chamonix's classic hikes not to be missed, in either direction. The trail, perched above the valley at the foot of the Aiguille de Chamonix, offers unrivalled views of the Chamonix valley (some chaotic passages are to be crossed). 2h30 to 3h00 by the Signal. Check the last return from the Montenvers train or the Aiguille du Midi cable car.

**Z7** Lac Bleu: this easy hike takes you to a little lake, nestled in a bowl surrounded by rock boulders at the base of the Aiguilles de Chamonix. 60 mn round trip.

Chamonix via Blaitière: the itinerary follows the same route as the Montenvers path before taking a left down towards the Blaitière alpine meadows which have recently been rehabilitated and are now exploited again. The trail, with no particular difficulty, is however long and pretty steep. 3 hours.

**Chamonix via Pré du Rocher:** Chamonix via the Pré du Rocher: at first, the path descends between large boulders, then runs down through the forest to Chamonix, passing under the cable car lines towards the arrival point. 2 hours.

30 Chamonix via Grand Bois: this downhill path offers wonderful views of the glaciers, the Mont Blanc and of the Aiguilles de Chamonix. 2 hours.



### Hiking from the top of Montenvers

**22** Le Signal Forbes: trek up to a magnificent view point over the Chamonix Valley, with views over the Mer de Glace on the way, and multiple cairns and rock slabs under the Aiguille de la République. 2 hours round trip.

**23** Chemin d'accès au glacier: Take the gondola and then the 170 steps to the ice cave. 30 min.

24 24 Traverse Montenvers-Plan de l'Aiguille: (see description on page 12)

**26 Descent to Chamonix via Caillet:** for a while the path runs alongside the railway before running through the forest to the chalet de Caillet (refreshments) and returns to Chamonix via Les Planards. 2 hours.

#### Hiking from Bellevue

33 Col du Tricot: From Bellevue follow a downhill path in the forest before reaching a clearing and then over a Himalayan style bridge over the torrent from the melting Bionassay glacier onwards to the Col du Tricot. Be careful on the way up. 4hoo round trip.

Descent Bellevue: From Mont Lachat descent to Bellevue by the Arandelys 1h one way. From Bellevue climb to 2h30 round trip.

#### Glacier de Bionnassay path:

- From Bellevue to the tongue of the Bionnassay glacier. 2h30 round trip.
- From Bellevue up to the Nid d'Aigle. 5h00 round trip.
- By the Plan de l'Are : Short easy ramble, ideal for families.  ${\tt 1}$  hour round trip.

## Hiking from le Col de Voza

**156 Tête de Charme:** Starting from the Col de Voza, this hike offers a beautiful view of the Dômes de Miage and the Bionnassay glacier. 2h30 round trip.

#### Mountain bike from Bellevue

From Bellevue, mountain bikes are allowed on the first and last train during off-peak service and on the first and last three trains during peak service.
