


## Process in case of a new size or change of component Annex to the deposit specifications

Before any announcement of a new calibre or change of component, the depositor will check that the movements comply with the latest version of the deposit specifications, available at <a href="https://www.cosc.swiss/certification/conditions-de-certification">https://www.cosc.swiss/certification/conditions-de-certification</a>.

Any exception to these deposit specifications shall be subject to a concession granted by the COSC. A time limit to be defined at the time of acceptance by the COSC applies to specific requests requiring a development approved by the Board of Directors, which will determine the economic implications.



Announce to the management of the COSC and to the relevant Control Office BO:


- > Any new calibre or time instrument, whether mechanical or quartz.
- > Any modification of components such as the dial, hand, calotte, stem or crown.



Transmit to the COSC management any change of calibre designation, modification of the calibre identification sheet, change of the logo on the individual certificate, etc.



Announce and send to the Biel Control Office BO (bobi@cosc.swiss) 5 to 10 items, meeting the conditions specified in the General Conditions and the Deposit Specifications, suitable for verification by test measurements. These pre-deposits for validation must be similar to the
