The sessions give babies, parents and carers the opportunity to enjoy gentle, nature-based sensory play and exploration outdoors, while helping new families connect and meet other parents.

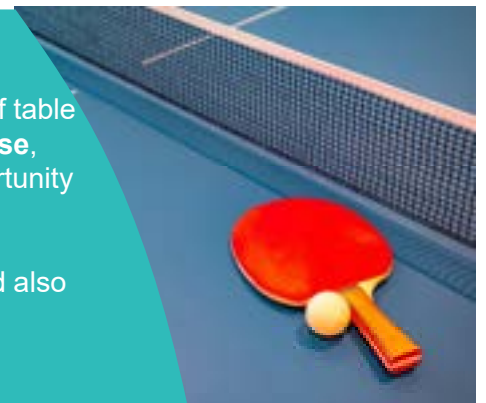
