



SAFETY RULES

MINI LAND ROVERS

Please read these rules out to everyone taking part before you begin your safety brief

By taking part in Mini Land Rovers, you acknowledge that there is a risk of injury and agree to give consent for you and / or the children in your care to participate. Please follow the safety rules and advice to ensure you have a safe and enjoyable drive. Concentrate on driving the vehicle, look where you are going, maintain a good distance and always be prepared to stop.

SUPERVISION

- Under 6's must be accompanied by an adult (18+) in the car.
- Over 6's must be accompanied by an adult (18+) who will walk round the track with them.
- 16-year-olds and over are responsible for their own safety.

SUPERVISORS (what to do)

- Supervise from the driver's side and stay within 3 metres of the vehicle so you can support with steering if required.
- You will be given a lanyard with an 'off' switch for the vehicle, please only use it to prevent a crash or collision.
Keep it in your hand for emergencies. To restart the vehicle, press the on/off switch again.
- If a collision or crash occurs, alert an instructor via the whistle on your lanyard, do not attempt to move the vehicle.
- Use the forward/reverse switch to reposition the car if required.
- The trails can be lumpy and bumpy, be mindful as you're walking and watch out for other drivers.

**You are responsible for the safe operation of the vehicle and its passengers during the session.
If you are not happy accepting this responsibility, do not proceed and we will be happy to give you a full refund.**

RULES

- Maximum age for driving is 17.
- Maximum weight per vehicle is 130kg (20.5 stone).
- **Remain seated** and keep arms and legs inside the vehicle.
- To steer point the arrow on the steering wheel in the direction you want to go.
- Push down on the pedal by your feet to go and lift your foot off to stop.
- The course is one way.
- Crashes and collisions **must be avoided** as they can damage the vehicle and cause injury.

BEFORE YOU START

- Please alert an instructor if you or anyone you are supervising has a pre-existing injury or medical condition (including pregnancy) that could affect your ability to participate safely or may increase your risk of injury.
- Driving gloves are available, from £3.95.
- Waterproof phone pouches are £6 if you'd like to capture memories of your adventure.
- Don't forget to purchase your Mini Land Rover Driving License for £3 at the end!
- Our activities are fun and energetic. A gentle warm up and stretch will serve you well before you begin.
- Make sure you've all been to the toilet.
