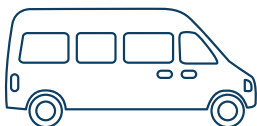

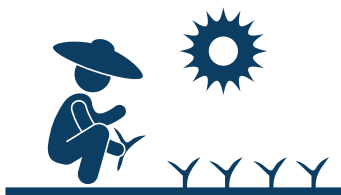
La Red Health Center

La Red Health Center is a federally qualified health care center. Part of its mission is to provide health care to vulnerable populations, the underinsured and the uninsured. LRHC is one of three FQHC's in the First State that provides care for Delaware's Homeless Population and agricultural workers. La Red provides health care services to individuals experiencing homelessness in Sussex County, including primary care, behavioral care, and case management. La Red also provides health care services to migrant workers who work at many of the farms throughout Sussex County.

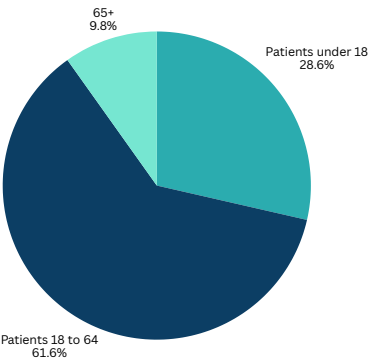
PATIENT DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

La Red Health Center

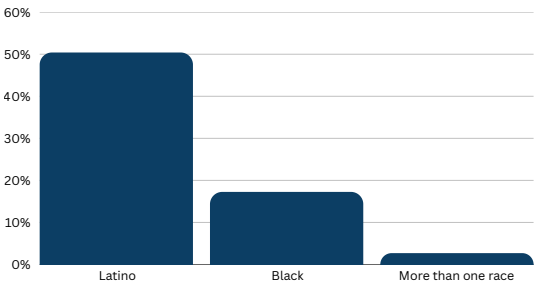
La Red Health Center was established in 2001 to address the medical needs of Sussex County's growing Latino population. La Red, meaning *The Network* in Spanish, grew from a small grassroots organization into a Federally Qualified Health Care Center with offices in Milford, Georgetown and Seaford. La Red Health Center is one of three FQHC's in Delaware and Sussex County's only FQHC provider. Today, La Red Health Center cares for a diverse group of patients, including those in the Hispanic, African American as well as the Haitian communities. La Red's mission has always been to provide quality care that is centered around patients and their families. Part of La Red's mission is to provide health care to vulnerable populations, the underinsured and the uninsured.

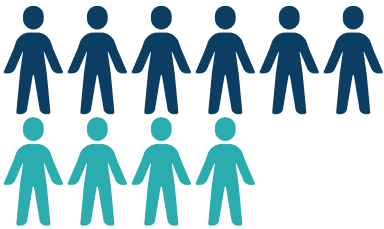

COST OF CARE

La Red Health Center

La Red Health Center is a federally qualified health center that serves as a safety net for more than 14,000 patients in Sussex County. La Red Health Center provides care to the county's uninsured, and underinsured. Approximately, **38%** of our patients are uninsured. **99%** of our patients are at or **200%** below the federal poverty level.

La Red Health Center

La Red Health Center does not turn patients away because they lack insurance or are unable to pay. La Red, a nonprofit, has several targeted funds to assist our patients who need help paying for emergency medications, surgical procedures outside La Red's scope of care, and other outreach efforts such as our Haircuts for the Homeless, Community Baby Showers and The Women's Health Walk programs. The demand for those charitable services continues to grow with our patient numbers as does the number of uninsured. Donations to those individual funds helps us continue to serve the needs of Sussex County residents who otherwise have difficulty accessing the health care they need.

Our Charitable Funds



Contributions to our annual fund helps us continue to offer quality care to Delawareans in need.



Contributions to our Link to Care fund helps us offer life saving care to patients who need specialized care such as hospital care.



Many of our maternal patients lack insurance or Medicaid. Donations pay for their care.



Donations to our Emergency Fund help pay for medications for our patients with chronic illnesses such as diabetes who cannot afford their medications.



Contributions to our Homeless Help fund allow us to provide haircuts and other affirming care that can lead individuals out of homeless.



Contributions to our Caring Community Fund help us provide items such a food, shelter and other wrap-around care.
