Regulations of the selection process and awarding of scholarship for attendance of the Polimoda Associate Course in Atelier Design - Academic Years 2020/2021 – 2021/2022

The Association Ente per le Arti applicate alla Moda e al Costume (hereinafter referred to as Polimoda), with registered office in Florence, Via Curtatone, 1, for the purpose of favouring the initiation of new studies and ideas that serve as inspiration for creative, artistic and economic development in the interests of society as a whole, has decided to offer 2 scholarships to the total value of € 28.000,00 each (€ 14.000,00 per year), for the attendance of the Polimoda Associate Course in Atelier Design (hereinafter the Polimoda Associate Course).

Each scholarship will cover the entire tuition fee of each year of the course.

The Polimoda Associate Course, which will be held in English, will have the duration of 2 (two) years and will start on September 28th 2020.

Please note that the scholarship does not cover housing and living expenses or any other extras.

In the case of non-assignment of all the aforementioned scholarships, Polimoda reserves the right to redistribute unassigned scholarships among other Polimoda Courses.

General Admission Requirements

In order to apply for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements. They must:

- be resident in the region of Tuscany for at least three years;
- have at least B2* level English;
- be aged between 17 and 25;
- be unable to bear the cost of the course.

Students who are already enrolled in a Polimoda Master Course, Undergraduate Course, Associate Course or Seasonal Course cannot participate in the selection process.

It is only possible **to apply for one scholarship** among those made available by Polimoda.

It is not possible to apply simultaneously for this scholarship, for one of those made available for Associate Courses for Italian citizens, for one of those made available for Undergraduate Courses for European citizens and/or for one of those provided for Master Courses.

Economic Requirements

The economic conditions of the applicant will be identified based on the values of the Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) of the family unit. Priority will be given to applicants whose family fall into the first bracket of ISEE certification.

Participation in the selection process for the scholarship is subject to the signing of the DSU 2019 relating to the applicant's family unit by the application deadline.

Selection process

In order to apply for the scholarship, candidates must complete the following steps:

- **Application Form submission** via the Course page on Polimoda's website;
- **Self-certification pursuant to Presidential Decree n. 445/00 certifying residence in the region of Tuscany for at least three years, ISEE Certification, Motivation letter** (1-page max), **Certificate (or self-certification) of English level (B2 required)**, must be sent via e-mail to scholarship@polimoda.com (specifying name and surname in the e-mail subject).

Polimoda will carry out checks on the veracity of the self-certifications produced by candidates.

Only in cases where it is deemed appropriate, the Head of Education will proceed to conduct a skype interview with the candidate.

Evaluation

The selection for the assignment of the scholarship will be carried out at the sole discretion of an admission committee composed of the Head of Education and two Course Leading Teachers (hereinafter “the admission committee”).

The admission committee will draw up a ranking of the top candidates, taking into account their economic requirements and their effective merits.

The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate listed at the top of the ranking. In case of equal merit amongst the candidates, precedence will be given to the candidate who first submitted the application form

Deadline and notifications

In order to participate to the selection process, candidates are required to apply for the scholarship no later than September 7th 2020.

The result of the selection process will be announced no later than September 11th 2020.

The selected candidate will have to give written confirmation to Polimoda of his/her intention to attend the Polimoda Associate Course and accept the scholarship no later than September 16th 2020. Should the candidate listed at the top of the ranking forgo, or be unable to benefit from the scholarship for any reason, the scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the ranking working down the list.

Before the commencement of the Polimoda Associate Course, the selected candidate must sign the course enrolment contract and the Polimoda Student Regulations relative to the programme for which the scholarship is assigned (please refer to the website www.polimoda.com).

The aforementioned documents will be applicable to all the phases of the training programme and on the signature of these documents, the candidate is undertaking to fully comply with the relative provisions of the same.

The scholarship awarded to the selected candidate for attendance in the Polimoda Associate Course in Atelier Design will be subject to said course being held. The course in question will be held subject to the minimum number (as established by Polimoda's Management) of enrolments being reached and therefore making the course viable to run. Confirmation will be given to the selected candidate at least 15 (fifteen) days before the start of the course as to whether the minimum number of enrolments necessary to activate the course has been reached, and consequently the definite assignment of the scholarship. Should the minimum number of enrolments for the Polimoda Associate Course fail to be reached, the scholarship may be used by the selected candidate to cover the fee of another Associate course organised by Polimoda in the same intake September 2020. The most appropriate course will be identified by the Head of Education together with the selected candidate, taking into account the aptitude, personal predisposition and *curriculum vitae* of the latter.
