HOW TO SUBMIT AN ePOSTER

1. Click [here](#) to submit your abstract.
 - Select your presentation type: Student Poster Presentation.
 - Under the field 'Select a topic' choose: Student Poster Competition.
2. Don't forget to [register](#) for the conference.
3. Once your abstract is approved (after March 23) [upload](#) a 2–5 minute video summary of your presentation.
4. By April 23, [upload](#) your PDF e-poster in the system.

ePOSTER INFORMATION

An e-poster combines a digital content display with interactive touchscreen technology.

The content is displayed digitally on a **55-inch TV screen**. Viewers can interact directly with the content using the touchscreen, navigating through different sections of the ePoster, zooming in on specific details.

Benefits:

- **Dynamic Content:** More engaging and visually appealing than static printed posters
- **Interactivity:** Allows viewers to explore content in a hands-on manner
- **Accessibility:** Content can be updated or modified without reprinting
- **Environmentally Friendly:** Reduces paper waste

SIZE & DETAILS

- There are no strict size restrictions, but a 2:1 width-to-height ratio is recommended.
- ePosters look best in a 16:9 horizontal format.
- Upload high-resolution PDFs, as files will be converted into images for display.
- ePosters may include images and text.
- Image quality depends on DPI (dots per inch)—low DPI images may appear blurred when enlarged. Use high-DPI images where possible.
