## Something Different

### White Wine

**Blanc de l'Observatoire – Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 2019 £27.00**

An interesting blend of aromatic white grapes: 45% Sauvignon Blanc 35% Muscat and 20% Clairette. The Sauvignon Blanc gives this wine its finesse and elegance, the Muscat its subtle flowery aroma and the Clairette its fruitiness,

**Malagouzia, Ktima Gerovassiliou, Epanomi, Greece 2020 £32.00**

Expressive & complex aromas of white pear, mango & lemon zest combine with floral notes. Refreshing the palate with a delicious flinty mineral character. This white grape variety was almost extinct until it was discovered in the 1970's by a Professor of Oenology who gave it to one of his students, Vangelis Gerovassiliou – the rest is wine history !!

### Red Wine

**Chat. Ksara Reserve du Couvent Bekaa Valley Lebanon 2018 £28.00**

Chateau Ksara is Lebanon's oldest winery. It can be traced back to 1857 when Jesuit monks acquired the property. A complex aroma of cloves, vanilla & mulberry. On the palate it has blackberry fruits and supple tannins.

**Domaine of the Bee – Languedoc Roussillon 2017 £37.00**

50% Granache 50% Carignan. These grapes come from 60-100 year old vines in the Coume de Roy. The result of a personal passion of Master of Wines Justin Howard-Sneyd who purchased 4 hectares of vines close to Maury. Enormously concentrated & intense with a black fruit, round tannins with a slatey minerality and huge finish!

### Chateau Musar – Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

**1998 £60.00**

Pale, jewel-bright garnet. Light, spicy, particularly well-integrated nose, already well developed. A sweet start on the palate; the opposite of heavy; a really lovely wine. Fresh, sweet, with some very slight mintiness & a dry finish. Very long, nicely mature – seems just right now. It will go beautifully with food. - *Janice Robinson, March 2018*

**2000 £60.00**

Garnet red with a tawny rim, lovely rose petal freshness on the nose, stunning for a 19 year old wine, beautifully textured palate, length, finesse & a harmonious finish – *Steven Spurrier 2019*

**2003 £75.00**

Deep ruby in colour, it has a complex, intriguing array of aromas: toasted bread, cigar box, fresh tea, plums & Eastern spices. On the palate, there are mature fruits, plums, figs & cherries with hints of tea leaves & dark chocolate. The wine is intense. The first taste releasing complex notes of currants, cherries & spice with a hint of game & finishing with a cleansing acidity. Our first indications were that the 2003 would be full bodied, powerful with great length and 7 years later upon release in 2010, we were proven right. *I think of the 2003 red as a classic Musar, a great vintage for Carignan – Gaston Hochar*

### English Wine

**New Hall Bacchus 2019 – Purleigh, Essex £27.00**

"Bacchus is England's answer to Sauvignon Blanc and the best examples such as this have a summer hedgerow-scented style that makes a great alfresco aperitif" – *Jane Macquitty, The Times 100 Best wines for Summer.*

**New Hall Pinot Noir Rose 2019 – Purleigh, Essex £27.00**

A brilliant salmon rose, with appealing and perfumed aromas leading to delicate summery strawberry notes and soft structure. A wine of purity and freshness.

**Oastbrook Estate Pinot Gris 2019 - Sussex £32.00**

Oastbrook Estate is an idyllic English vineyard in the heart of the Sussex countryside, close to Bodiam The Oastbrook Estate vines are grown at a relatively low altitude of between six to 30 metres above sea level in a south facing vineyard in East Sussex, where the temperate microclimate produces premium grapes. An aromatic and beautifully balanced Pinot Gris offering a mouth-watering array of baked apple and lifted pineapple aromas. Rich and intense, with a touch of spice on the salivating finish

Extra dry with aromas of white peach, pear & flowers. Palate is fresh, dry & clean as a whistle all the way through

### Cottonworth – Hampshire, England

**Classic Cuvee -Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier £45.00**

Brimming full of soft aromas of apple & citrus notes, enhanced by a pleasant breadly minerality

**Rose – Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier, Pinot Precoce £45.00**

Magnificent display of red summer fruit aromas. Beautifully balanced on a subtle backdrop of vanilla

### Champagne Drappier – Urville, France

**Carte D'Or -100% Pinot Noir £50.00**

Fresh nose evoking pear, lemon & hazelnuts. On the palate, a very dry mineral Champagne, bursting with life. A delight for the purists

**Blanc de Blancs – 95% Chardonnay, 5% Blanc Vrai £60.00**

Light & airy. The nose brings to mind white peach & pear but also floral notes such as peony. On the palate, minerality with light biscuit. Creamy, subtle & seductive

**Brut Rosé – 100% Pinot Noir £64.00**

Well structured with fine purity of red fruits. Very striking on the nose & similar on the palate. Warm & satiny. Lightly spiced with balanced hints of stone fruits and a fresh finish

**Grande Sèndrée 2010 55% Pinot Noir, 45% Chardonnay £98.00**

Wood aged single sourced. Golden coloured. This Champagne reveals subtle aromas of dried fruits, toast & wax. It unfolds into fruity notes of citrus, white flesh & stone fruits

**Grande Sèndrée Rosé 2010 70% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay £108.00**

Wood aged, single source. A complex bouquet opening on to notes of strawberry & gooseberry. Pure on the palate with elegant roundness and a liveliness from the chardonnay
