Chateau L'Aumérade Cuvée Marie Christine Rosé (rosé)

Provence, France. Grapes Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah 2019 £6.50(175ml) / £9.60(250ml) / £13.95(375ml) / £19.20(500ml) / £28.75(Btl) A lovely pale powder pink hue, with refreshing aromas of grapefruit leading to succulent peach and apricot on the palate. Fruit forward and full, with a hint of spice, this elegant rosé has a refreshing acidity and a long finish

<u>Jim Barry 'The Barry Bros' Shiraz (red)</u>

Claire Valley, Australia 2017

The wines of Jim Barry are renowned throughout the wine world as icons of Clare Valley. Juicy and vibrant with aromas of raspberry, blackberry and cherry lifted by notes of violets and sweet spice. Great structure on the palate with elegant savoury tannins enveloping the fruit through to an everlasting finish

The Oak Bistro - Chateau Lestrille, Capmartin Superior (red)

Bordeaux, France. Grape 93% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 £7.00(175ml) / £10.00(250ml) / £15.00(375ml) / £20.00(500ml) / £30.00(Btl) A medium bodied Claret, concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes. It has good freshness, quality tannins, nicely balanced, velvety and powerful. This was our 10th anniversary red wine in 2019

The Oak Bistro - Chateau Lestrille, Entre Deux Mers (white)

Bordeaux, France. Grape -Sauvignon 85%, Muscadelle 15% 2018 £6.60(175ml) / £9.45(250ml) /£14.15(375ml) / £18.85(500ml) / £28.25(Btl)

A bright and fresh unoaked Bordeaux bursting with zesty lime, pear and slight grassy aromas. Pear and citrus on this lively palate with a wonderful fresh minerality. Chosen to celebrate our 10th anniversary

Oastbrook Estate Pinot Gris (white)

East Sussex, England, Grape - 100% Pinot Gris 2019 £7.50(175ml) / £10.70(250ml) / £16.00(375ml) / £21.35(500ml) / £32.00(Btl) An idyllic English vineyard in the heart of the Sussex countryside, close to Bodiam The Oastbrook Estate vines are grown at low altitude of between 6 to 30 metres above sea level in a south facing vineyard in where the temperate microclimate produces premium grapes. An aromatic and beautifully balanced Pinot Gris offering a mouth-watering array of baked apple and lifted pineapple aromas. Rich and intense, with a touch of spice on the finish.
