Chateau L'Aumerade Cuvée Marie Christine – Provence (Rosé)

Provence, France. Grapes Cinsault 35%, Grenache 35%, Syrah 30% 2022

The Château de l'Aumerade is a 400-year old estate located in the heart of Provence. Originally belonging to the Aumerat family, the traditional Mas property dates back to the Renaissance period. The Cuvée Marie-Christine rosé is made exclusively from an 89-hectare Cru Classé parcel, located on the plains of Pierrefeu. A lovely pale powder pink hue, with a refreshing character of ripe strawberries combined with stone fruits.

Rioja Gran Reserva – Bodegas Ondarra (Red)

Ebro River Valley, Rioja, Spain, Grapes – 90% Tempranillo, 10% Mazuelo 2016

Bodegas Ondarra was founded in 1985, with the aim of creating wines which showcase the region's distinct terroirs. Situated in the town of Viana overlooking the Rioja Valley in Rioja Oriental, Bodegas Ondarra is the only winery in the village of Viana. The complex and mature bouquet offers rich fruit aromas, along with hints of spice and notes of raisined fruit layered with tobacco and leather. Elegant and velvety, this is classic Gran Reserva Rioja.

The Oak Bistro – Chateau Lestrilie, Bordeaux Superior (Red)

Bordeaux, France. Grapes 93% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

A medium bodied Claret, concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes. It has good freshness, quality tannins, nicely balanced, velvety and powerful. This was our 10th anniversary red wine in 2019.

Ad Hoc Cruel Mistress Pinot Noir – Larry Cherubino (Red)

Pemberton, Western Australia. Grape - 100% Pinot Noir 2022

Former 'Winery of the Year' by James Halliday and Matt Skinner, Larry Cherubino wants his wines to be distinctive and to speak clearly of their variety and vineyard site. From the Margaret River & Pemberton to the regions of the Great Southern, Larry Cherubino's knowledge of these regions & his relationships with the growers enables him to source the best vineyards for each variety. The fruit for this wine was carefully sourced from a selection of vineyards in the Great Southern region in Western Australia. The nose shows graphite, minerals and juicy black cherries. A hint of spicy oak plays a supporting role. The palate is softly textured, fresh and vibrant, flavours of black cherry & earthy beetroot carried along by a soft, silky finish.

Vouvray Les Calcaires – Dom. Rouletiere, Jean-Marc Gilet (White)

Loire, France, Grape - 100% Chenin Blanc 2022

A classic Vouvray with attractive aromas of apple, grape and vine peach complemented by mineral overtones. Beautifully balanced with a lively and persistent finish. The grapes are grown in a single vineyard 'les Calcaires', which is certified organic; the grapes are grown without the use of synthetic or chemical preparations. The vineyard covers Turonian limestone hillsides, interspersed with confluent valleys and is covered with 'perruche', a flinty clay soil brings elegance to the wine

The Oak Bistro – Chateau Lestrilie, Entre Deux Mers (White)

Bordeaux, France. Grapes – Sauvignon 85%, Muscadelle 15% 2021
