Chateau L'Aumerade Cuvée Marie Christine – Provence (Rosé)

Provence, France. Grapes Cinsault 35%, Grenache 35%, Syrah 30% 2022

The Château de l'Aumerade is a 400-year old estate located in the heart of Provence. Originally belonging to the Aumerat family, the traditional Mas property dates back to the Renaissance period. The Cuvée Marie-Christine rosé is made exclusively from an 89-hectare Cru Classé parcel, located on the plains of Pierrefeu. A lovely pale powder pink hue, with a refreshing character of ripe strawberries combined with stone fruits.

Cotes du Rhone Villages, Plan de Dieu Vieilles Vignes – Dom Saint Damien (Red)

Rhone, France Grapes – 80% Grenache, 15% Mourvedre, 5% Carignan 2022

Saint Damien was an early Christian saint (martyred in the year 287 A.D.), who was considered to be the patron saint of doctors. A chapel was built in his honour in the tiny hamlet of La Baumette, just outside the village of Gigondas. The grapes were harvested at optimum maturity and were then vinified for 30 days in the traditional manner, followed by eight months ageing in concrete vats. Bottled without fining or filtration. A savoury, warm and spicy full-flavoured wine, with layered flavours of prunes and garrigue from this award-winning producer.

The Oak Bistro – Chateau Lestrilie, Bordeaux Superior (Red)

Bordeaux, France. Grapes 93% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

A medium bodied Claret, concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes. It has good freshness, quality tannins, nicely balanced, velvety and powerful. This was our 10th anniversary red wine in 2019.

Rioja Gran Reserva – Bodegas Ondarra (Red)

Ebro River Valley, Rioja, Spain, Grapes – 90% Tempranillo, 10% Mazuelo 2016

Bodegas Ondarre was founded in 1985, with the aim of creating wines which showcase the region's distinct terroirs. Situated in the town of Viana overlooking the Rioja Valley in Rioja Oriental, Bodegas Ondarre is the only winery in the village of Viana. The complex and mature bouquet offers rich fruit aromas, along with hints of spice and notes of raisined fruit layered with tobacco and leather. Elegant and velvety, this is classic Gran Reserva Rioja.

Soave Classico – Ca Rugate San Michele (White)

Veneto, Italy, Grape - 100% Gargenaca 2022

The family business has been handed down through the generations of the Tessari family since the early 1900s. The estate was renamed Ca Rugate in 1986, taking its name from the volcanic hills where the vineyards are located. Light straw gold in colour. A fine bouquet of meadow flowers, with hints of camomile, elderflower and iris. An elegant wine with notes of sweet almond on the finish

The Oak Bistro – Chateau Lestrilie, Entre Deux Mers (White)

Bordeaux, France. Grapes – Sauvignon 85%, Muscadelle 15% 2021
