Chateau L'Aumerade Cuvée Marie Christine – Provence (Rosé)

Provence, France. Grapes Cinsault 35%, Grenache 35%, Syrah 30% 2022

The Château de l'Aumerade is a 400-year old estate located in in the heart of Provence. Originally belonging to the Aumerat family, the traditional Mas property dates back to the Renaissance period. The Cuvée Marie-Christine rosé is made exclusively from an 89-hectare Cru Classé parcel, located on the plains of Pierrefeu. A lovely pale powder pink hue, with a refreshing character of ripe strawberries combined with stone fruits.

Negroamaro Il Pumo – Sam Marzano (Red)

Salento - Puglia, Italy, Grapes – 100% Negroamaro 2024

In 1962, 19 vine growers from San Marzano whose families had farmed the land for generations, combined their efforts to establish 'Cantine San Marzano'. Through the decades this cooperative has grown significantly, attracting over 1,200 top-quality growers. Biodiversity within the vineyard is encouraged by the planting of indigenous grape varieties, alongside Mediterranean trees and plants which are resistant to drought thereby reducing water waste. The wine has intense aromas of blackcurrants and wild fruits are complemented by subtle notes of spice and thyme in this full-bodied Negroamaro. Charmingly balanced and juicy on the palate, this is full of the flavours of Southern Italy.

A Juicy, mellow & savoury wine, full of flavour of raisined red fruits & moreish !

The Oak Bistro – Chateau Lestrille, Bordeaux Superior (Red)

Bordeaux, France. Grapes 90% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

A medium bodied Claret, concentrated fruit aromas backed by delicate woody notes. It has good freshness, quality tannins, nicely balanced, velvety and powerful. This was our 10th anniversary red wine in 2019.

'Notios' White – Gaia Wines, Nemea (White)

Nemea Peleponese, Greece. Grapes – 34% Assyrtiko, 33% Moschofilero, 33% Roditis 2024

One of the pioneers of the modern Greek wine revolution Gaia Estate was established in 1994 by Greek winemakers Leon Karatsalos and Yiannis Paraskevopoulos. The Moschofilero grapes come from the mountainous vineyards of Arcadia region & have fruity characters and crisp acidity. The Roditis from upland Corinth, in a microclimate which imparts elegance to the resulting wine. The Assyrtiko grapes come from the slopes of Koutsi. Notios (The Southerner) is a fusion of traditional Greek varieties resulting in a light, fresh and elegant wine. The Moschofilero contributes vibrant, floral flavours, the Roditis imparts a smooth citrus zesty character and the Assyrtiko delivers wonderful complexity, crisp acidity and a mineral finish.

Parallele 45 Cotes du Rhone Blanc – Paul Jaboulet (White)

Rhone, France. Grapes – 30% Grenache Blanc, 30% Viognier, 20% Rousanne, 15% Marsanne, 5% Clairette 2024

Founded in 1834 and cultivating the iconic terroirs from the northern Rhône Valley across seven appellations. Parallele 45 is named after the famous latitude on which renowned wine producing regions are located worldwide. This cuvée represents the domaines' commitment to organic viticulture and respect for natural balance. The wine was aged for six months in stainless steel vats on the fine lees, resulting in a cuvée with lovely purity of fruit and freshness.

Mouthwatering aromas of apricot, citrus and white floral notes lead to a full bodied palate balanced by exquisite freshness, through to a delicate, fruity finish.

The Oak Bistro – Chateau Lestrille, Entre Deux Mers (White)

Bordeaux, France. Grapes – Sauvignon 85%, Muscadelle 15% 2022
