Where previously we have reported Scope 1, 2 and 3 combined, with some Scope 3 categories excluded from our emissions reporting for the baseline year 2021, we have instead opted to report a baseline of 2021 for Scopes 1 and 2 and create a new baseline year of 2023 for all applicable Scope 3 emissions.

All of the emissions reported in this Carbon Reduction Plan have been verified by PlanetMark to provide assurance in the quality of data.

CDS DS is Planet Mark certified up to and including December 2025.

Our PlanetMark certification includes all of the categories of emissions reported here.

Emissions Reduction Targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

Scope 1 and 2

- > 2030 Halve our emissions
- 2036 Reduce by 80%
- > 2045 Net Zero

From 2021, we set ourselves a minimum of a 5% reduction target, year on year, with our long-term target being to halve our emissions by 2030, to 51.35 tCO2e, and achieve Net Zero by 2045.

Scope 1 and 2 emissions have reduced by 85%.

We project that our Scope 1 & 2 carbon emissions will remain fairly static over the next 5 years Achieving this means we will be on track for halving our emissions by the end of 2030.






Figure 1 – Scope 1 & 2 Carbon Reduction Projection

Scope 3

We project that our Scope 3 carbon emissions will decrease over the next 5 years to 990 tCO2e by 2030. This is a reduction of 30% which is a result of a 6% annual reduction target against our baseline emissions. Our longer-term target to achieve a reduction of 90% against our baseline will mean increasing the pace of these reductions from 2030 onwards. At which point we will have a robust procurement programme in place.

Progress against these targets can be seen in the graph below:




Figure 2 - Scope 3 Carbon Reduction Projection



Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following measures and projects have been completed since the 2021 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 86.7 tCO2e, a 85 % reduction against the 2021 baseline.

- Procurement of renewable energy contracts reducing our market-based emissions
- Installation of solar panels at our Cheltenham site
- Implementation of the ISO 50001 standard which includes a range of actions including LED lighting, PIR sensors and closer management of the heating and cooling systems
- Reduction of fleet and replacement of petrol and diesel vehicles with hybrid
- Closure of Cheltenham site on Fridays
- Installation of electric car chargers
- Carbon reduction transition workshop with senior leaders

Future Initiatives

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Online lunch and learn for employees to increase awareness of how their individual actions can make a difference
- Upskill CDS DS Sustainability Coordinator to deliver accredited carbon literacy training
- Inclusion of the sustainability strategy within new starter inductions
- Implementation of a CDS DS Green Team
- Keep under review the status of business fleet and options to replace with greener alternatives
- Analyse our business travel reporting to identify trends in higher-emission travel and investigate appropriate mitigation
- Embed sustainable practices within procurement process
- Investigate potential of procuring used/re-purposed IT equipment/ancillaries
- Implementation of sustainable travel policy
