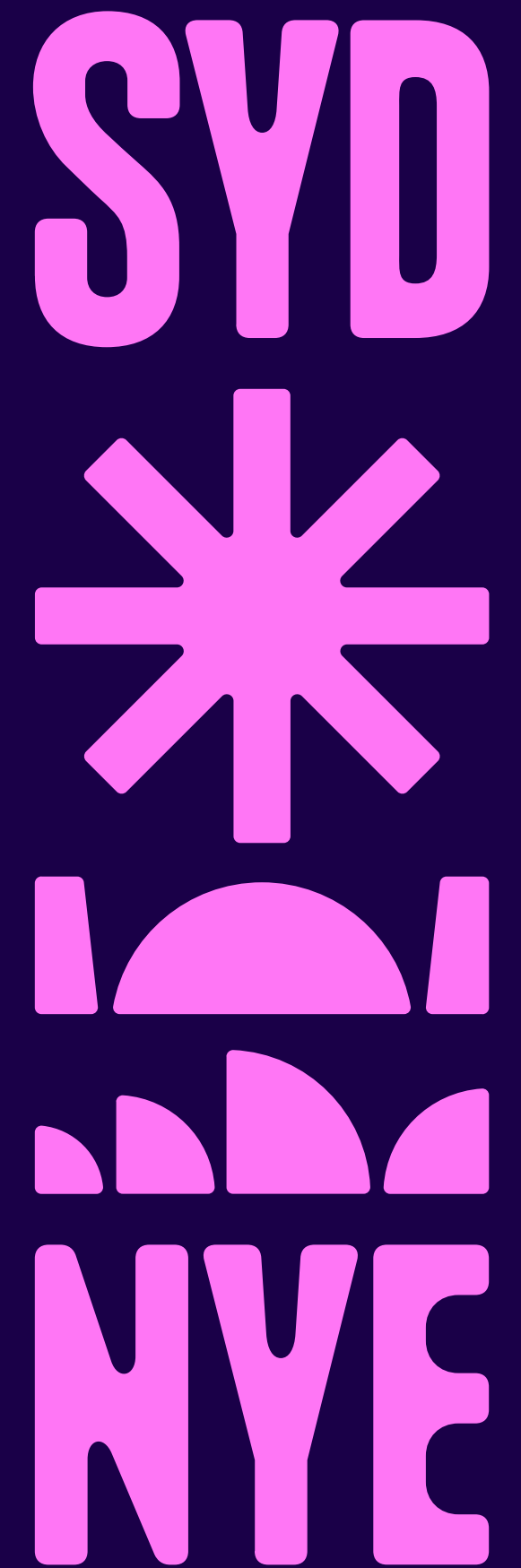


PIRRAMA PARK VISUAL STORY

General information

- Pirrama Park is open from 2pm to 1am
- You can buy food from food trucks or bring your own snacks
- There will be loud music from 7pm until midnight

General information

- There is an accessible shuttle service from 5pm to 1:30am
- If you need help, there are staff in blue vests who can help you

What to expect

You will be outside for a long time so should prepare for summer weather. You should bring:

Hat and sunscreen

Water bottle

Blanket, rug or chair to sit on

Games or other things to do



There will be large crowds and lots of noise. If you are sensitive to noises and lots of people you should bring:

Headphones

Your own sensory toys

Sunglasses

Getting there – public transport

Public transport is the best way to get around on New Year's Eve



- You can catch the L1 light rail to Pirrama Park.
- The closest station is John Street light rail about 500m away from the park.
- You can walk from the light rail.
- The walk will take 5 to 10 minutes.
- The walk from the light rail is downhill.
- You can catch an accessible shuttle service from 5pm to 1:30am.
- The shuttle will stop near the light rail on Harvey Street and Bowman Street.

Getting there – driving

Driving is not recommended but if you need to drive you can...



- Drive on Pirrama Rd until 5pm.
- Pirrama Rd will close from 5pm to 4am.
- Catch an accessible shuttle service from 5pm to 1:30am.
- The shuttle stops at Harvey St, Bowman St and Pirrama Park.
- There is limited street parking.
- Wilson Carpark is about 450m away from the park.

Accessibility

New Year's Eve at Pirrama Park is an accessible event.

You can find:

- a designated accessible viewing area (sold out)
- haptic vests and headphones from 6:30pm
- an accessible shuttle service from 5pm to 1:30am.
- a quiet space – it is okay to feel overwhelmed or to need a break



Accessibility

You can also find:

- a continuous path of travel around the park
- accessible maps at the park and online
- accessible toilets
- guest help
