Safety & Enviroment

Port Security

All our Cruise port facilities are ISPS certified

- Port facility is fenced off and security checked prior to each arrival
- Security guards on site while ship is present at port facility
- Minimum two security guards on duty
- At passenger turnaround, more guards are called in

It is strictly prohibited to open fence gates unless port security is present

- Extra guards are added on duty if additional gates are needed for example at turnaround

Access control at terminals

Guests and provisions need to be noticed in advance

Provisions

- Drivers need to announce their presence in terminal
- Port security will control access through gates

Manned guarding on site and CCTV accessible on site and remote

Mandatory baggage screening at all turnarounds

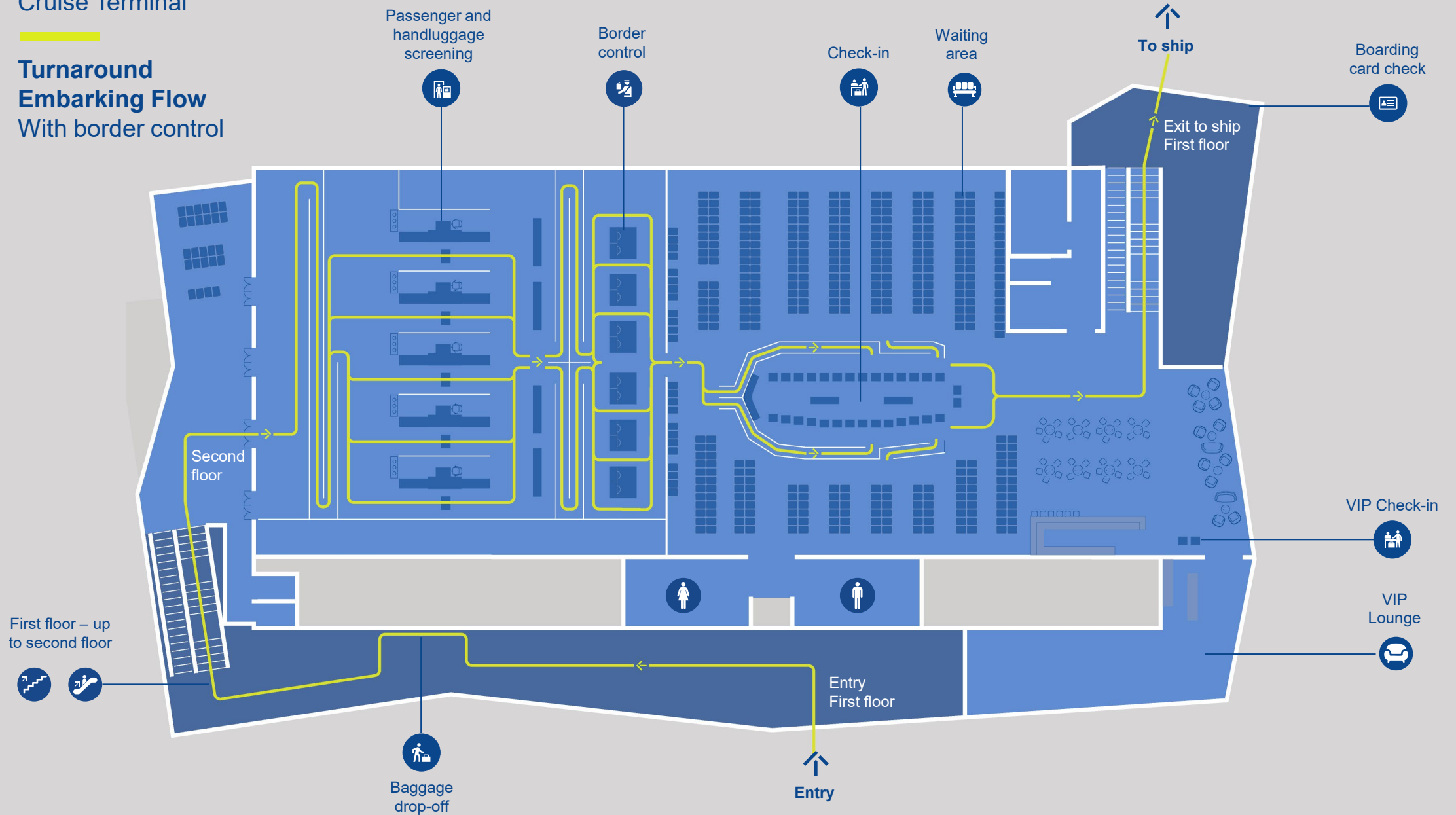

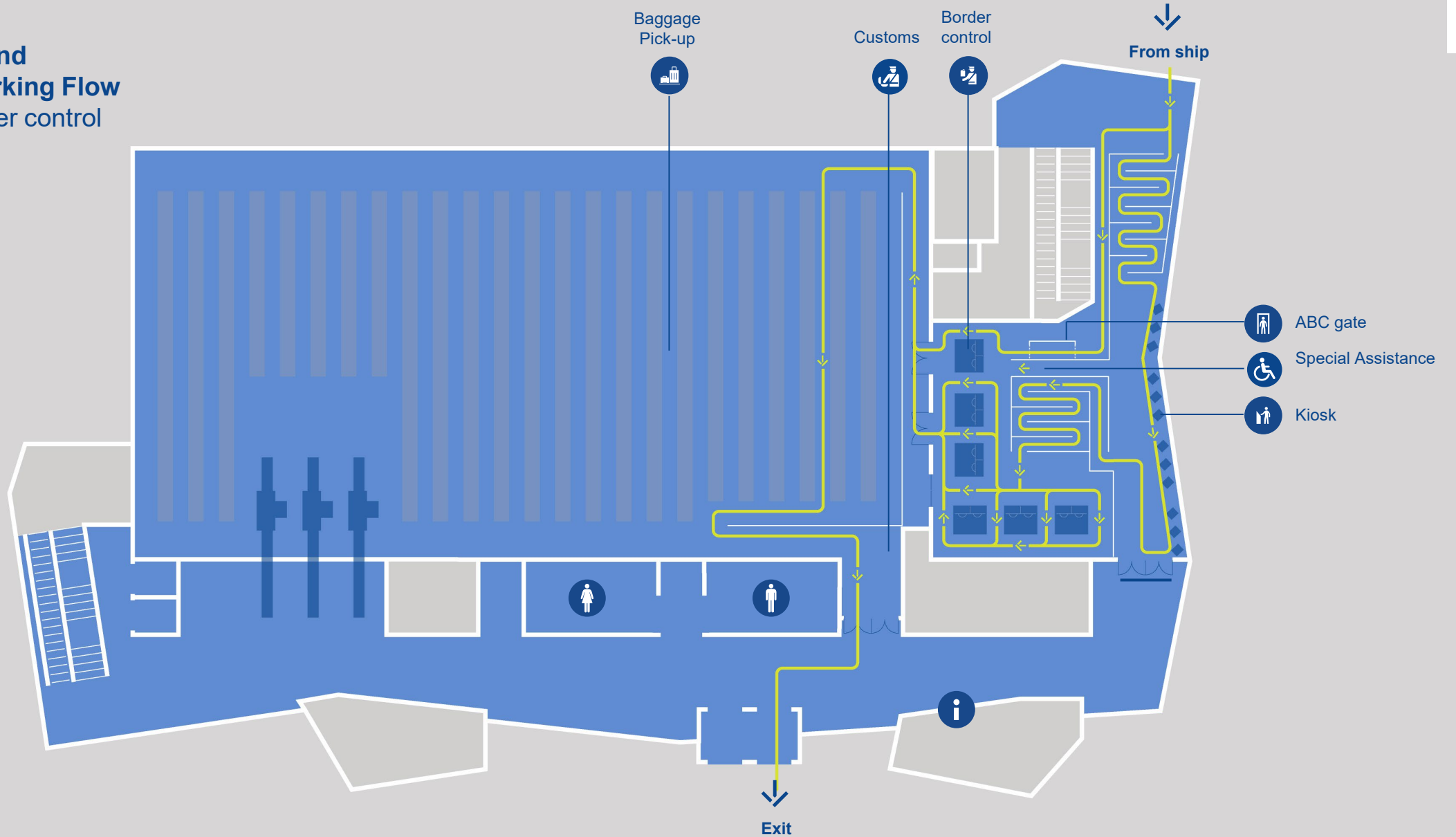
Turnaround Embarking Flow With border control

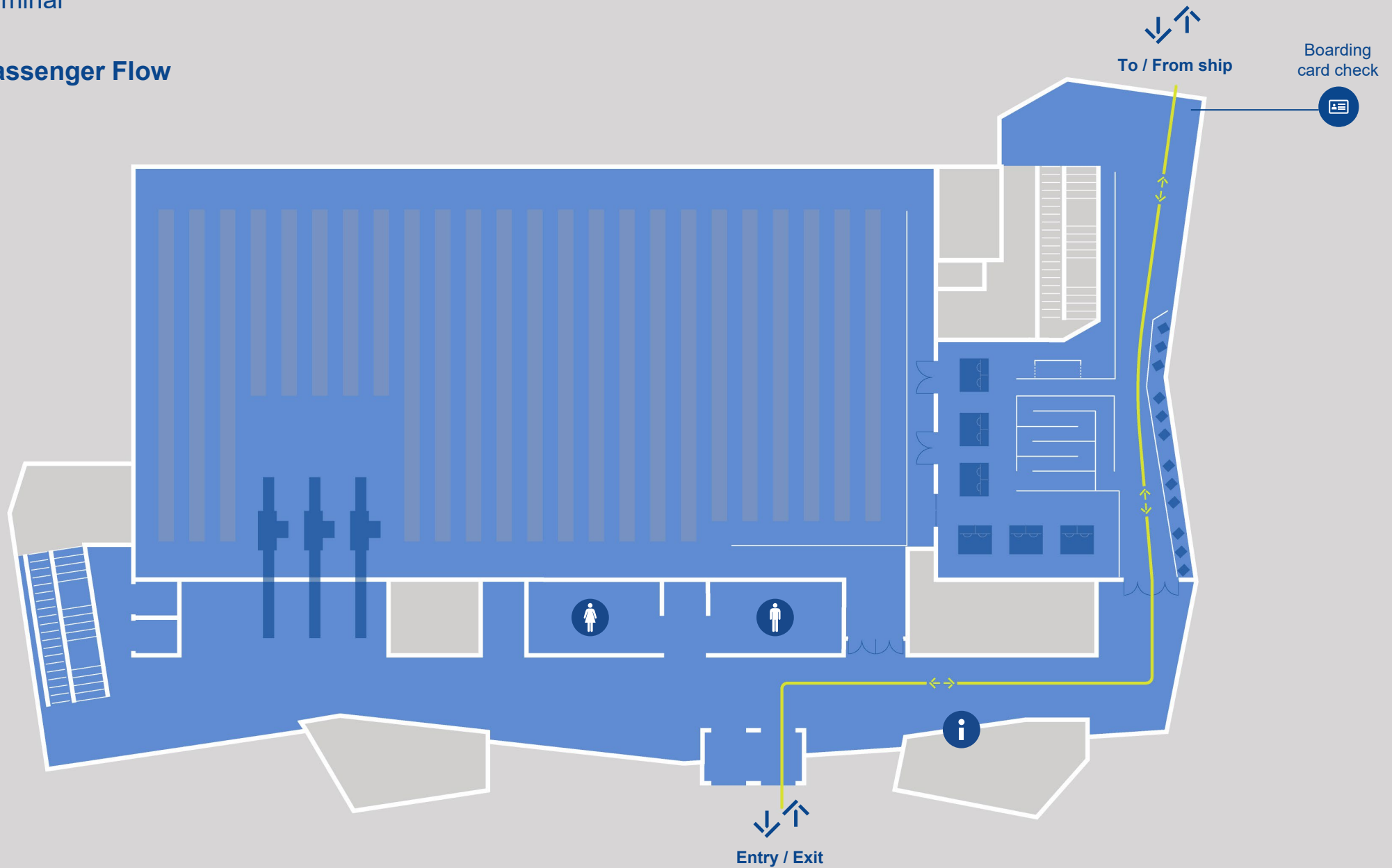

Transit passenger Flow



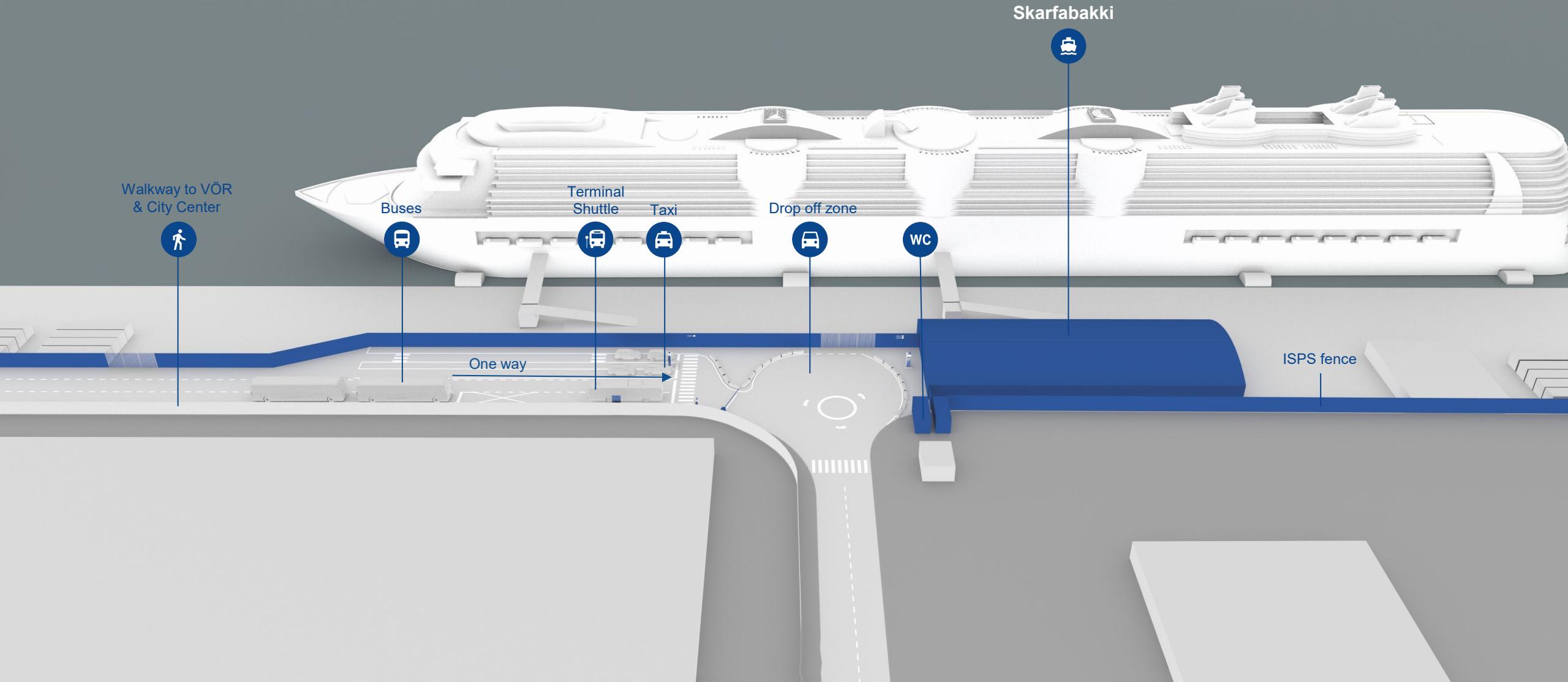

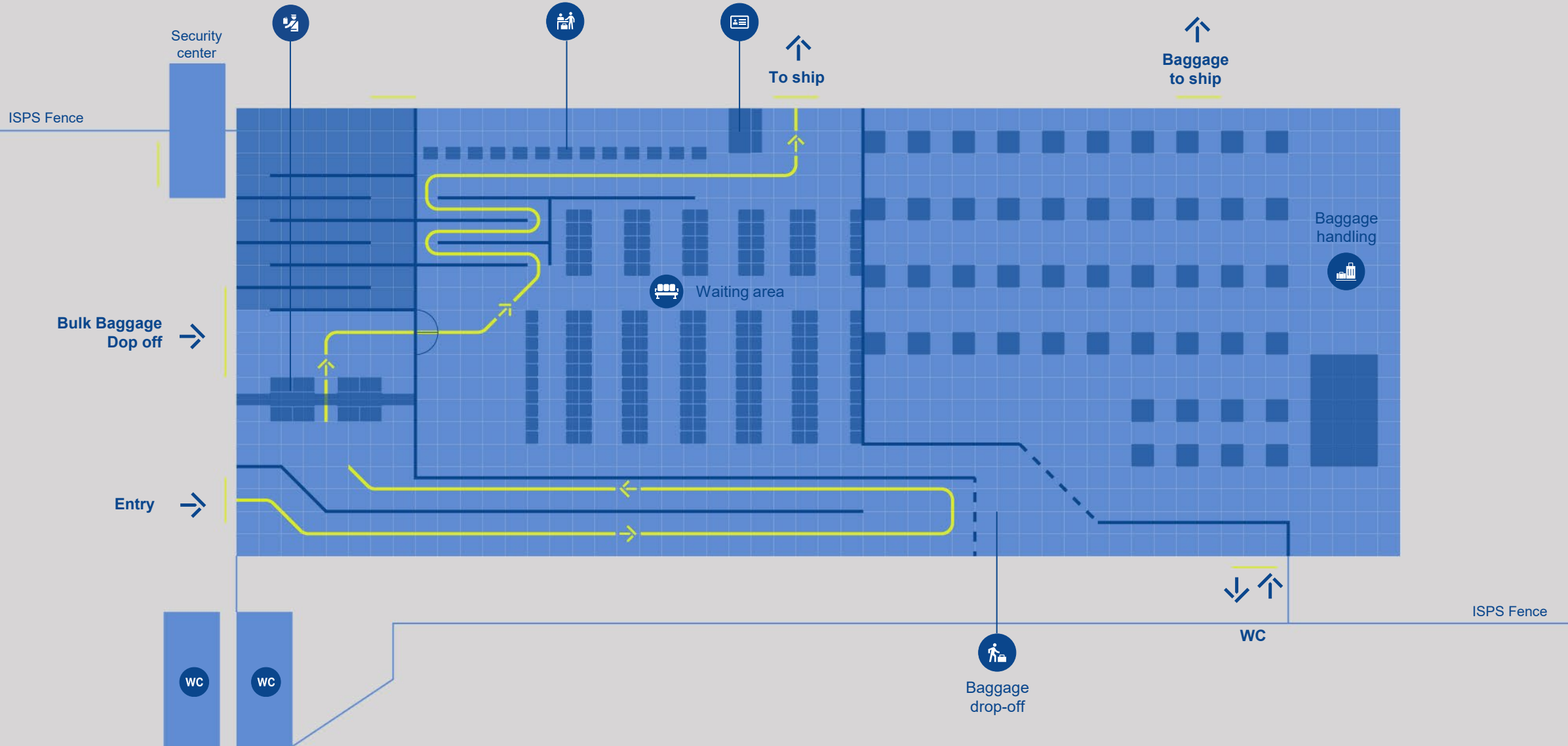

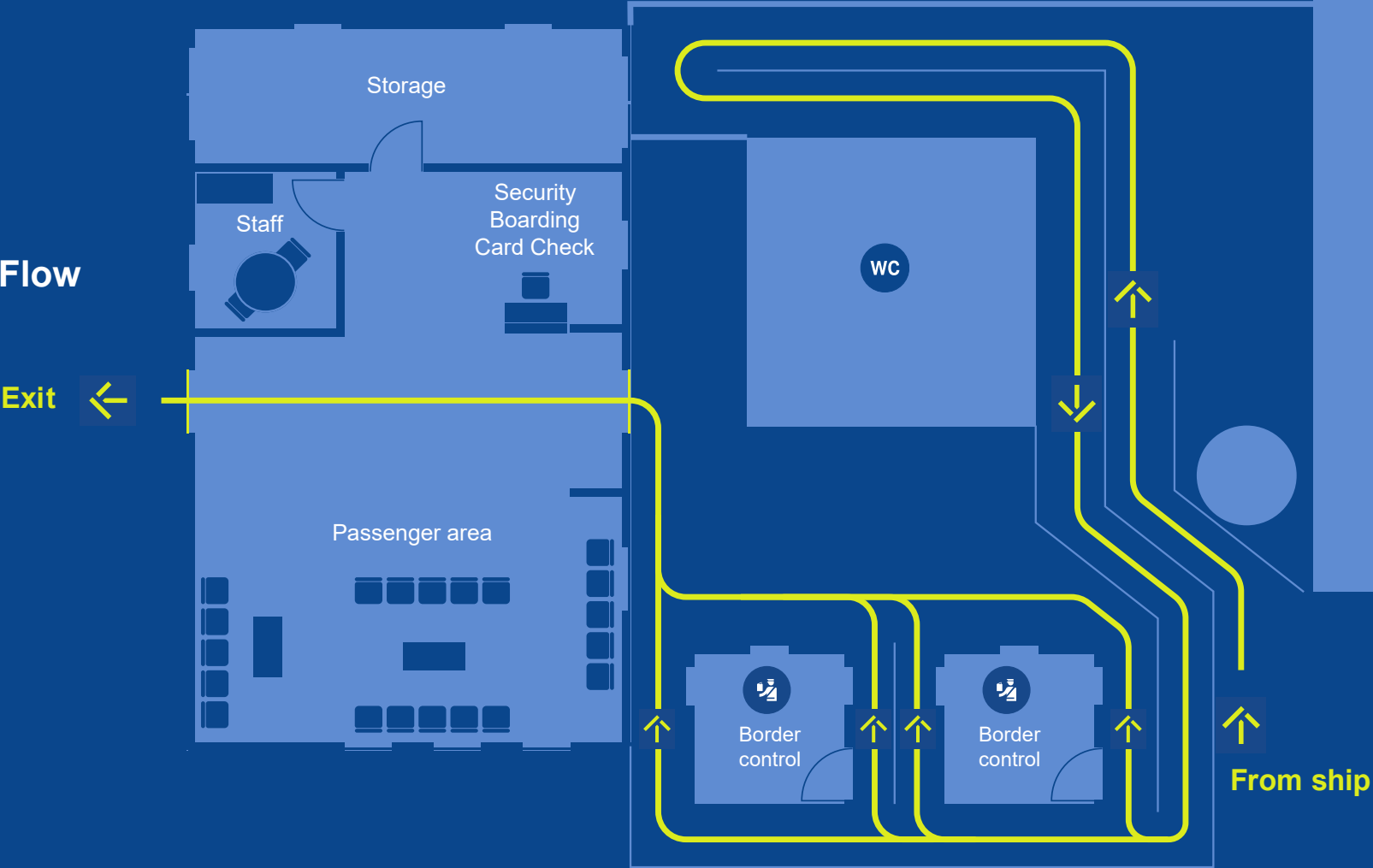

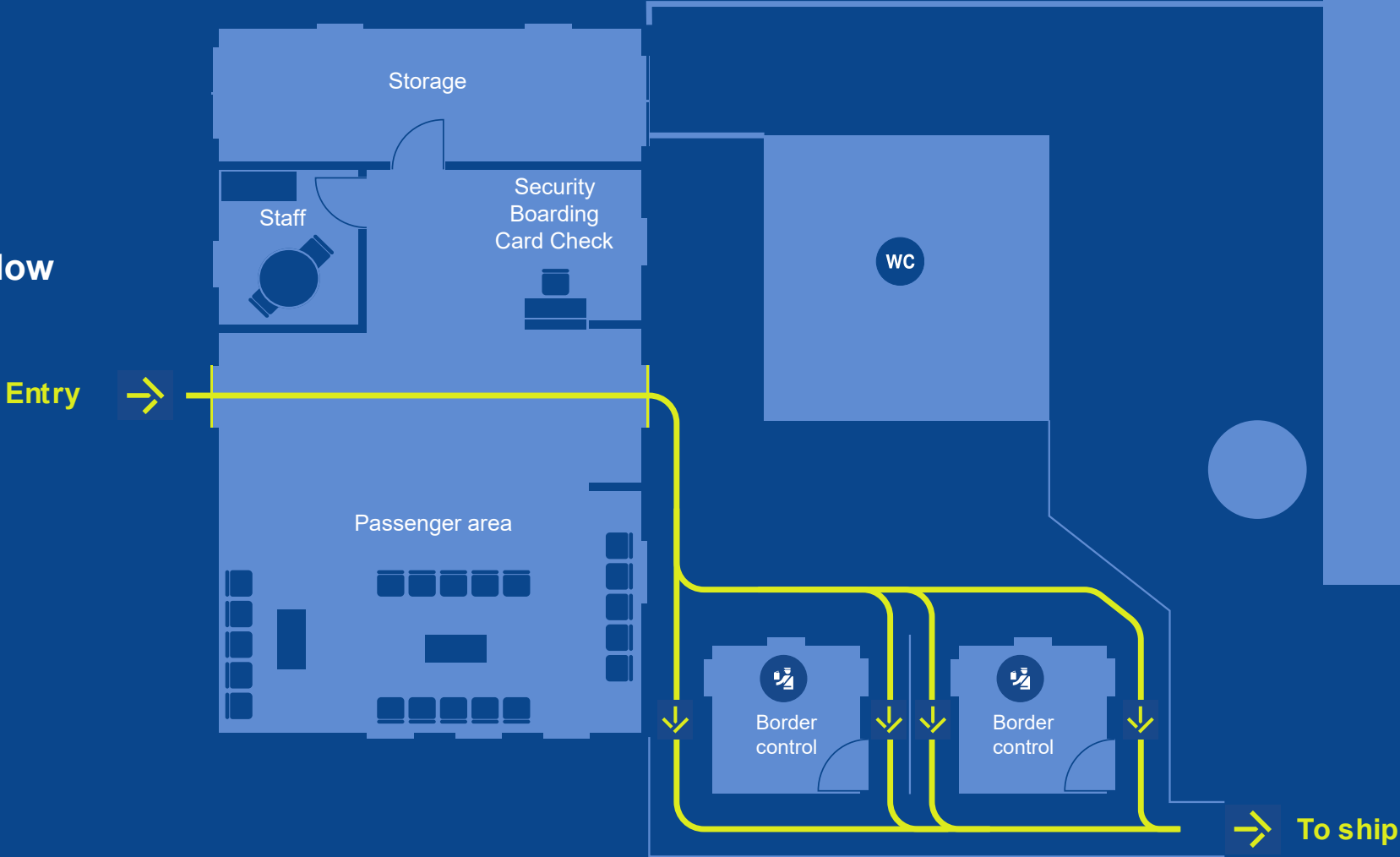
Disembarking Passenger Flow

Embarking Passenger Flow With border control



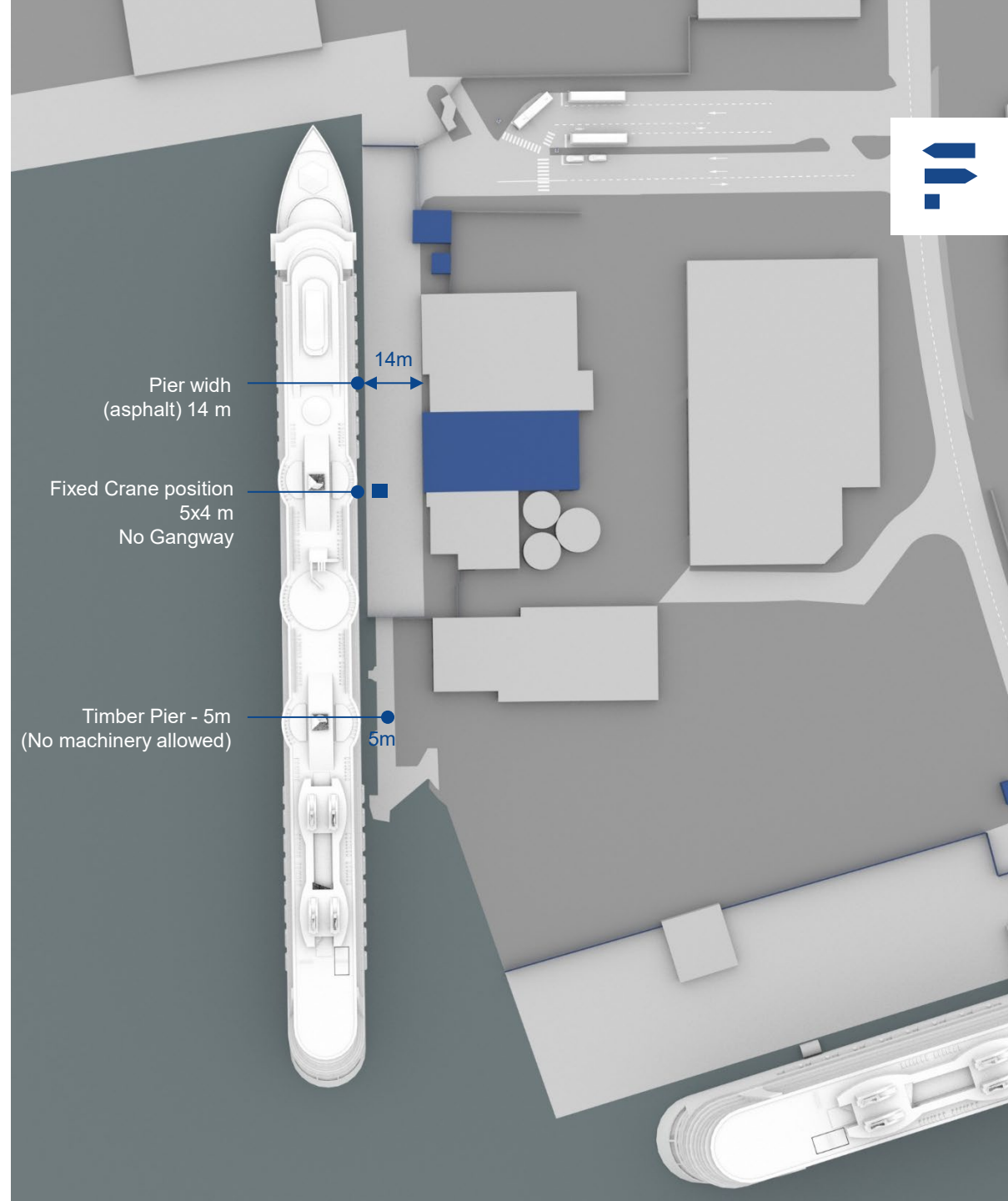
Attention!

Gangways:

- Yokohama fenders are mandatory (diameter 3,5m) if port gangways are used:
 - Pier is only 14m wide
 - Outer part of the pier, approx. 55 meters, is not accessible for passengers

Please note that activity area on pier is limited.

- Garbage, Baggage and provision arrangements to and from ship need to be planned prior to call.
- Shell doors must be allocated in line with asphalt pier
 - Any other arrangements will require additional resources

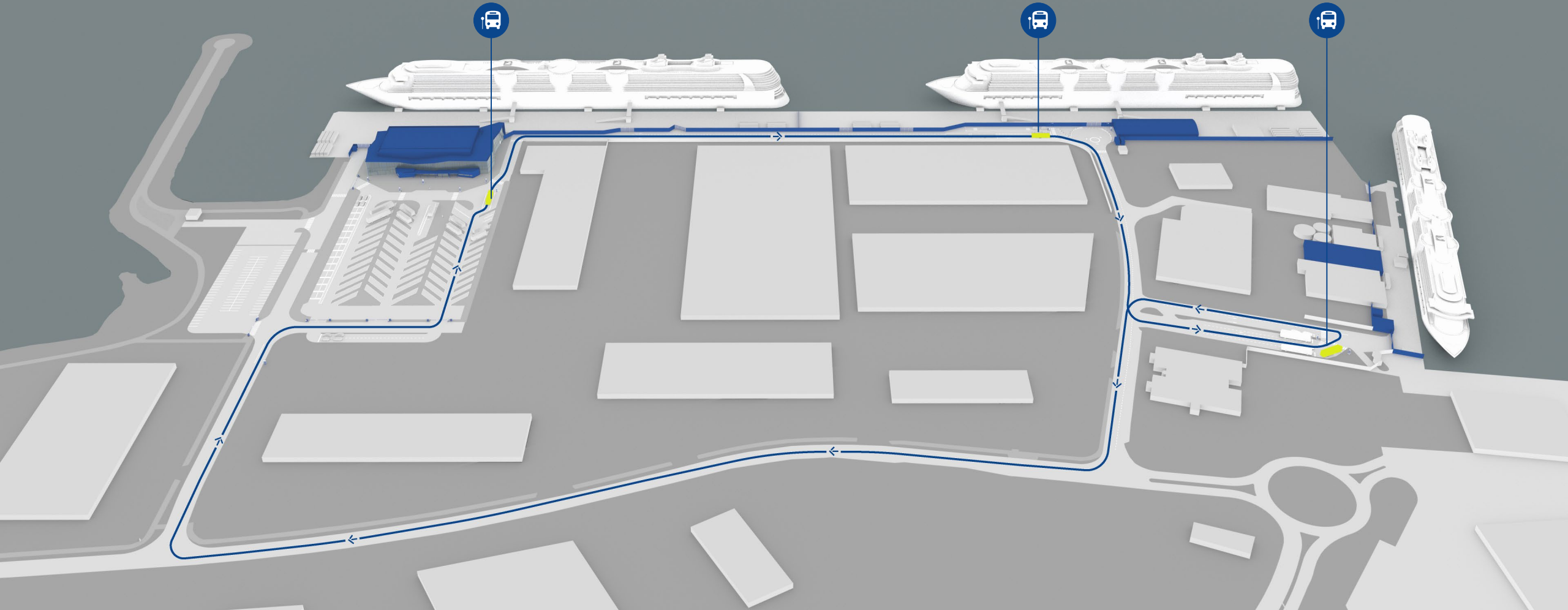

Wayfinding

Öryggisstoðun Security



The wayfinding system consists of several blue pillars and signs:

- Information Pillars:** Two large pillars with 'Upplýsingar Information' at the top. They feature maps and lists of services such as Terminal, WC, Check-in/Security, Baggage drop-off, Bus 1-14, Bus 15-23, Taxi/Small bus, City bus, Terminal Bus, and Walkway/City center 5 km.
- City Bus Pillars:** Two pillars with 'Miðbær City Bus' at the top, showing routes to 'Miðbær City center' and 'Kongurbrú'.
- City Center Pillars:** Two pillars with 'Miðbær City center' at the top, showing routes to 'Kongurbrú' and 'Skarfabakkur'.
- Passport Control Sign:** A tall, thin sign with 'Vegabréfa athörftur Passport control' and an icon of a person with a bag.
- Bus Route Pillars:** Three pillars on trapezoidal bases. The first is for 'Rúta Bus 32', the second for 'Smá-rútur Small buses', and the third for 'Smá-rútur Small buses' with distance markers: '500 m Skarfabakkur 312' and '8 km Miðbær City center'.

Platform height 3m



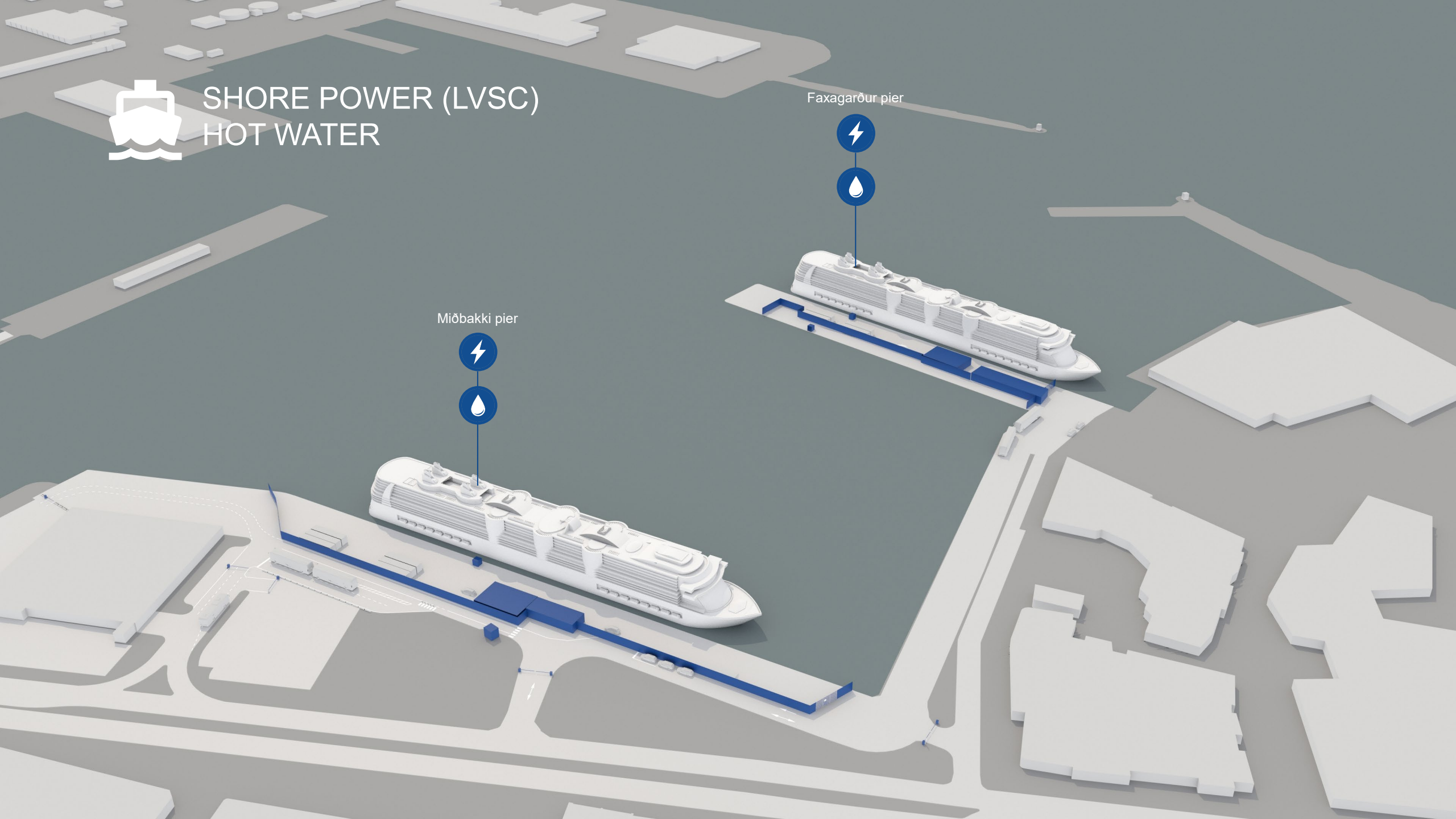
