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REGULATION INFERNO 2025

The INFERNO race is a running event with obstacles. The event is structured in one or more running events of between 2 and 14 km in length with the presence of natural and artificial obstacles, on mixed asphalt and dirt or snow-covered terrain, open to all men and women over 16 years of age (from 12 years of age for shorter distances), in possession of regular medical certification (see specifications below).

The map and participant guide are published prior to each event and are to be considered an integral part of these regulations.

Any further limitations or restrictions due to regulations, DPCM decrees or other legal norms with respect to what is stated below will be communicated on the event website and on the relevant social channels.

1. PATH AND OBSTACLES

The total length of the course may vary for each event and will be announced on the event website. The course will include obstacles, both natural and artificial. The official course map will be published on the website www.infernorun.it In addition to dexterity, climbing, jumping and swimming skills, running speed will also be essential to complete the competition. The course may also include crossing ditches, forests, rough terrain, with wood, logs or roots, wires or ropes, rubble or surface rocks, frozen or snow-covered sections, crossings of rivers, streams, lakes, natural or artificial pools of water. The risk of tripping and falling is constant.

The organizers would like to point out that during the crossing of obstacles, as well as on the entire race course, injuries and/or accidents may occur between participants. In addition, dangers can be caused by falls or actions of participants involving other competitors. We therefore recommend that you adapt your pace to the terrain, the visibility conditions, the type of obstacle to be tackled and the crowding of the course section. Each obstacle has its own rule of execution and engagement that must be followed for the safety of all parties involved.

Due to the number of participants, visibility of the race course is not always ensured. In this case, participants are forbidden to continue at full speed. It is mandatory to reduce speed to adapt to the terrain and visibility conditions. When approaching each obstacle, the participant must pay close attention to the information signs present and the instructions of the obstacle management staff. More detailed information on the route and its obstacles can be found on the official event website and in the Participants' Guide.

2. RACE, RULES AND DISQUALIFICATION

Obstacles are present on the course to test participants. The race is open to competitive and non-competitive participation.

COMPETITIVE RACE - PRO (with sports medical certificate for competitive activity)

Competitive participants will start first in one or more "bolge" (batteries) reserved for them, will have a race number printed on each wristband and will be equipped with one or more chips for recording their race time. The race management reserves the right to divide or shift the participants (e.g. men and women or the composition of the batteries) if it deems it necessary for organizational or health reasons.

The management reserves the right to vary the times and the battery (battery) selected during registration if this is functional for the running of the race.





Athletes who are serving a disqualification for doping or are disqualified by the Italian OCR Federation are prohibited from participating in the competitive race.

For participants in the competitive race, obstacles must be overcome correctly and not circumvented, without outside help. Otherwise, the obstacle cannot be considered to have been overcome.

Each competitive athlete is provided with five (STANDARD RACE) or three (SHORT RACE) wristbands - also called bands - depending on the distance of the race course. They must all be worn and are required to enter the starting cage, are personal, carry the bib number and cannot be given away.

EACH ATHLETE WEARS 5 or 3 BRACELETS ACCORDING TO THE RACE (STANDARD OR SHORT). ON THE SUSPENSION HURDLES ONLY ONE PASS ATTEMPT MAY BE MADE PER HURDLE. EACH HURDLE FAILURE RESULTS IN A WRISTBAND BEING CUT.

Before the finish line the athletes are 'filtered' according to the number of wristbands in their possession:

- with 5 wristbands for the standard or 3 wristbands for the short can continue directly to the finish line for time recording
- with 0 wristbands they can continue directly to the finish line for the timekeeping. They will be in the ranking without finish position as DNF but will still be shown the finish time
- with at least 1 wristband they must perform the penalty loop (1 to 4 times depending on the race) to make up the missing wristbands. On successful completion of the race the athlete may continue to the finish line for timekeeping.

PENALTY LOOP

- Consists of a test of running, carrying or strength or other
- It must be completed a number of times equal to the number of bracelets lost, up to a maximum of 4 for Standard races and 2 for Short races.
- It is placed near the finish line
- Those who do not pass the penalty loop will have all their wristbands removed and will be considered DNF (did not finish) after the finish line.
- In order to control the passage of athletes on the Penalty Loop, an electronic control platform can be set up on the course of the Penalty Loop which will be kept as proof of passage in addition to the wristbands.

For each failed obstacle, a band is cut, which is retained by the judge as evidence for a possible final check. As one arrives at the finish line with zero wristbands (DNF, did not finish) or with three for the Short or five for the Standard, the final classification is drawn up on the basis of the finishing time and includes only those who have three for the Short or five wristbands for the Standard on their wrist.

Once the course has been completed and in any case before the start of the race, the race director will announce the time limit beyond which you will not be counted in the ranking.

The race director may make use of a sweeper service (an athlete of the organization who starts last) who 'cleans' the course and closes the competitive race. This system may be replaced or supplemented by time gates indicating a time limit within which to arrive at a certain point of the course or at the finish.

Competitive athletes are forbidden, under penalty of disqualification, to try the obstacles before the race. It will be the care and responsibility of each competitively competing participant to ensure that at the finish line the race judge registers the number of wristbands correctly. Each athlete is responsible for his/her own control devices (wristbands and chips), the absence of one or more of these cannot be contested in any way. Immediately after the finish line each competitor must register the number of wristbands with which he/she finished the race.

The course may not be cut; athletes who take advantage of this by shortening the course or avoiding obstacles will be disqualified. An electronic inter-timing platform will be used to provide this real time recording and to





check the actual passage. Incognito judges may also run among the athletes to report to the judge at an obstacle or at the end of the race any misbehavior or award penalties. Athletes must not leave anything they take with them along the route, including gels, food or anything else. Abandonment of rubbish may lead to disqualification.

For anything not provided for in these regulations, please refer to the regulations of the Italian OCR Championship issued by the Italian OCR Federation and the Italian OCR Championship available on the respective websites

PENALTIES

The fastest athletes may ask for road and space to pass by shouting 'road' or 'permit' or similar. Competitive athletes who are joined by non-competitive athletes have no priority in the queue at obstacles. Athletes in the non-competitive buoys will have no penalty for failing to pass an obstacle.

Rules valid for competitive athletes on obstacles NOT IN SUSPENSION:

- use first attempt and second attempt lines immediately, if the latter are free
- in the case of a second attempt use only the second attempt lines
- in the case of multiple attempts, use only the second-attempt lines
- in the event of a failed attempt, if there is a queue, return to the back of the line and wait your turn
- it is forbidden to touch the structure supports
- the number of attempts is unlimited (except for suspended obstacles)
- in case of abandonment go to the judge and have your wristband cut off

NON COMPETITIVE RACE - OPEN (with sports medical certificate for NON-competitive activity)

Participants in the OPEN race are under no obligation to overcome obstacles, which they may attempt an unlimited number of times. They must assess the obstacle and their own ability to overcome it before proceeding to attempt it. Participants in the OPEN category are equipped with timing chips, the ranking will be drawn up on the basis of the finish time but will not be valid for FIOCR rankings, qualifications and rankings. In the OPEN category the current sanitary regulations, i.e. for illustrative purposes the spacing, must be applied in any case.

No prize-giving is provided for the OPEN category.

Organization personnel will monitor the course and obstacles to ensure that the race proceeds smoothly and in accordance with the rules. In the event of non-compliant behavior, the staff may report the bib number to the organization and the competitor may be disqualified even if he or she finishes the race. The course and obstacles are designed in such a way as to limit the waiting time in front of each obstacle as much as possible. However, in the event of a wait, the Organisation expects each participant to behave in a fair and polite manner. Please remember that INFERNO is a potentially dangerous obstacle course and the safety of participants is the Organisation's top priority.

The organizers reserve the right to change the course or close individual obstacles at any time. Each participant is obliged to behave in a fair and sporting manner!

Disrespectful or offensive behavior towards staff, volunteers or judges may be punished by disqualification from the race and reporting for further sanction to the Italian OCR Federation.

3. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Participation in the event is open to members of the organising society and the EPSs to which the organising society is itself affiliated. Participation will be permitted from the age of 12, for longer races there may be greater restrictions, regardless of nationality and gender.





MEDICAL CERTIFICATION

For participation in the OPEN category, a sports medical certificate for recreational (or non-competitive) sporting activity is required. Participation in the PRO (competitive) category requires a sports medical certificate for competitive activity (type B1), valid on the date of the race or issued no more than 12 months previously. For Italian athletes, it is compulsory to send a copy of the valid medical certificate for competitive activities according to the telematic modalities on the race website. The medical certificates accepted are those that correspond to model B1.

The medical certificate must be uploaded online by the day before the event on the registration platform. It will be possible to present it on the day of the race (also in paper format), in which case the organization reserves the right to ask for up to 20 euros for administration costs.

Participation will not be allowed for those who only present a sports federation card, RUNCARD or other sports promotion organization card, which is not accompanied by a medical certificate. Foreign athletes must have the certificate made available by the organization at www.infernorun.it completed, stamped and signed by a doctor.

The organisation reserves the right not to accept a medical certificate that is illegible or unclear and consequently not to allow participation in the race. THE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE MUST BE VALID ON THE DAY OF THE RACE (medical certificates that have expired on the day of the race will not be accepted)

WAIVER

At the time of registration, on www.infernorun.it, those wishing to take part in the INFERNO sign the knowledge and acceptance of these regulations and the relevant releases on the processing of images, GDPR and privacy information also available as an annex to these regulations.

Additional disclaimers and/or health certifications may be requested where the regulations in force on the date of the event so require.

4. HOW TO REGISTER

First-time registrants enjoy preferential treatment over last-time registrants. The minimum registration fees are listed on infernorun.it

The registration fee includes:

- Timing service with microchips and wristbands
- official INFERNO gadget (size subject to availability)
- bag storage service (if available and if health regulations permit)
- shower service (if available and if health regulations permit)
- final refreshments (if and as health regulations allow)
- water points on the route (if and as health regulations permit)
- swag
- sports insurance cover

The registration procedure can be found on the official website www.infernorun.it. In order to proceed with registration, the following are required: personal data, acceptance of privacy, acknowledgement and acceptance of the regulations, the health waiver where present, a copy of the medical certificate (which can also be uploaded later, before the date of the race) and payment of the registration fee in the prescribed manner.

Entries can only be made online at www.infernorun.it and the accepted methods of payment are indicated on the same site.

The organization reserves the right to close or re-open registrations at any time it sees fit and in any case by giving notice on www.infernorun.it.

Entries will not be canceled or refunded for any reason that prevents the entrant from participating.





In the event of cancellation of the event due to a public order emergency or natural disaster, participants will be granted a voucher to register for an event in the next 12 months or, at their choice, a refund of 100% of the amount paid net of payment processing fees on the platform used.

To CHANGE OF CATEGORY, i.e. switching from the OPEN category to the PRO category, is regulated as follows - send your request by email to iscrizioni@infernorun.it - :

- the delta to be paid will be communicated, i.e. the difference between the quotas of the two categories (if places are available)
- no cost for change from PRO to OPEN

To CHANGE OF NAME (change of participant's name) is settled as follows - by sending your request by email to iscrizioni@infernorun.it - :

- **10 euro for change of ownership up to 7 days before the event**
- **no change possible within 7 days before the event**

To TRANSFER TO ANOTHER INFERNO RACE while maintaining the same ownership - send your request by email to iscrizioni@infernorun.it - :

- **10 euro for change of ownership up to 7 days before the event**
- **no change possible within 7 days before the event**

The day before the event is defined as a request received by the above-mentioned channels by 11.59 p.m. on the eighth day before the event in question. For example, if the race is on Saturday 26 April, the request must be received by 23.59 on Friday 18 April

The organization for each of the changes described above will produce a digital voucher for use on the registration platform of the value necessary to complete the registration process for the agreed change within 30 days of the production of said voucher. In the terms of this 30 days of validity, the value of the voucher will not be changed, even if the cost of the registration fee for the chosen race increases. This procedure may be replaced by an automated procedure on the registration platform.

5. SUSTAINABILITY

The organisation and its partners respect environmental sustainability in all aspects of their activities. Therefore, all participants and persons involved in the event are obliged to protect the environment. Compliance with legal regulations relating to the environment is an essential condition for taking part in the event. This concerns above all waste management, soil conservation, water conservation and pollution control. Specific waste collection containers will be set up and all participants are invited to actively participate in waste collection. A shoe collection service will also be set up.

6. BIB AND RACE PACK (SWAG) PICK-UP

Race bibs and the race pack can be collected at the INFERNO Village on the day of the race or in other ways that will be communicated. Bibs may also be collected by third parties, with a written proxy and a photocopy of a valid identity document of the delegating person. Collection by third parties may be prevented by health regulations. The race bib is strictly personal, cannot be tampered with and is not transferable to anyone.

7. TIMING AND TIME LIMIT





Participants in the race will be equipped with one or more chips to record their race time, and a finish order will be drawn up on the basis of the time recorded. The measurement of times and the processing of finish orders will be carried out electronically and failure to return the transponder chip may result in a charge of up to €10 for the participant.

The time limit is set for each race and communicated in the 'athletes' guide' and at the start. Beyond this time, the organisation will not guarantee assistance on the course and the safety of the race route and timing will not be continued. Any participant who fails to meet this limitation will be recorded as 'NOT COMPLETED' in the results list. In any case, the race can be completed by all participants crossing the finish area.

8. BAG DROP, CHANGING ROOMS AND SHOWERS

Changing rooms and bag storage, if such facilities are available and permitted by governmental and sanitary regulations in force on the date of the race, are available to participants near the finish/start area. The shower service, if available, may be subject to waiting times depending on the number of participants. In this case, we recommend appropriate and civilised behaviour while waiting.

The organisation accepts no responsibility for personal items unattended or forgotten in these areas or for theft or damage.

9. MODE OF DEPARTURE

Athletes taking part in the competitive race will start first, in one or more groups (bolge) depending on their overall number and the health regulations in force. The number of PRO and OPEN HELL groups (bolge) will be decided by the organisation on the basis of the number of participants, obstacles, safety and health regulations in force.

The Organisation reserves the right to change the procedure and starting times to improve the smooth running of the race. In such cases, changes will be communicated in good time.

10. ATHLETE RESPONSIBILITY

The athlete is obliged to be informed about the regulations, how to overcome the obstacles and the details of the event communicated on the official event website.

The registered athlete is responsible for the ownership and safekeeping of his race bib and acquires the right to use all the services mentioned in these regulations and/or subsequently communicated.

a) Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part without a race bib, in addition to being held liable for damage to persons or property, including himself, will incur sporting sanctions under the jurisdiction of the federal bodies and may be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the offence of 'theft' (art. 624. penal code).

b) Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part with a forged or otherwise non-compliant bib number, as well as being liable as indicated above, will incur sporting penalties and may also be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the offence of 'theft' (art. 624. criminal code), or, alternatively, for the offence of fraud (art. 640. criminal code). In cases a) and b), participants may be liable to the penalties laid down for the offence of 'failure to comply with the provisions of the Authorities' (Article 650 of the Criminal Code). The aforementioned cases will only be found after verification of photographic and/or video documentation.

11. AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded to the first three men, the first three women and the first three teams in the competitive race. If logistics and timing permit, prizes will also be awarded to the first in each age category.





The prize-giving ceremony will take place approximately two hours after the end of the competitive race at the finish area. The final results and the alphabetical order of finish will be published if possible in real time and in any case after the end of the race on the official website and/or the timing service website.

Prizes, if available, will be handed out only and only to those who are present at the ceremony, they will not be delivered afterwards or even sent out.

The prize-giving will in any case be carried out in accordance with current health regulations.

12. MEDICAL SERVICE AND ASSISTANCE

The organisation will provide an appropriate medical service on the route and at the start and finish points. Ambulances, first-aid facilities and paramedical services, located at key points along the route, will provide the appropriate medical service to all participants. The doctors and paramedical personnel are authorised to prohibit injured, overworked or injured participants from continuing the race in order to ensure the medical safety of all participants.

13. OBSTACLE WARNINGS

Walls and wooden palisades are to be overcome by passing over the wall using whatever technique the participant feels able to perform safely for himself and others.

Each wall may have imperfections and cause small wounds caused by splinters of wood. The obstacle must also be tackled with due attention to the landing part on the opposite side.

Each participant must assess his or her own physical condition and the condition of the ground on which the obstacle rests and on which he or she is to land. In the event of rain or other weather, the contact surfaces may be slippery and offer less grip and support. Ropes may be present to assist in overcoming the obstacle; such ropes should only be used for their intended purpose. For example, ropes for ascending should not be used for descending.

It is the responsibility of each participant to check that each rope is held correctly before use.

Exiting or disengaging from the obstacle must be performed according to the rules of each obstacle. Each obstacle may vary the method of exit, which must always be performed in the safest way for the participant.

In the case of balance hurdles the support surface is reduced and can be slippery and lead to the athlete falling. In the case of rain or other weather events, the surfaces may be even more slippery.

In weight-carrying obstacles, each participant must assess his or her own endurance and technique appropriate to the effort in order not to drop the carried object either himself or herself or on the other participants. Carried objects must be supported but not dropped or thrown when completing the obstacle.

In water obstacles where swimming is required, it is compulsory to know how to swim, otherwise it is forbidden to engage such obstacles; to do so without knowing how to swim puts one's own and others' safety at risk and is liable to penalties.

In mud pools it is forbidden to dive head-on and it is compulsory for each participant to assess before entering that the entry area is free and clear of other participants in order not to run the risk of being even partially submerged or of submerging others.

In suspended obstacles, each participant must assess his or her grip capacity (grip on the obstacles). It is possible to skip a grip and go directly to the next one by assessing one's athletic ability but with the knowledge that there is a greater likelihood of losing the grip and thus falling.

Each participant must therefore avoid finding themselves even momentarily in positions or situations that prevent a safe landing for themselves or others.

On all obstacles the position of the feet must remain lower than that of the head





Finally, each participant must consider that during the course it may happen to find themselves partially or completely wet and that therefore, for example, wet hands may have a lesser or different grip on all types of obstacles, leading to a greater risk of accidents and/or falls

14. FINAL ADVICES

The event will be held in any weather conditions, without prejudice to the Organization's right to suspend the race for reasons related to the safety of participants or public order.

The Organization reserves the right to cancel the event, postpone it, bring it forward or delay it and to modify these regulations at any time for reasons it deems appropriate for better management of the race or for the health of participants, at its sole discretion.

Any changes to services, locations and times will be duly communicated to registered participants via email and will be reported on the infernorun.it website.





Addendum Inferno Team race of 3 participants

INFERNO TEAM

INFERNO organizes an OCR race for freely composed teams on a course that will be defined with about 15 obstacles to overcome together. It is not a relay.

This regulation must be considered an integral part of the general one in force which, with the participant guide, constitutes a single body of rules.

1. RACE, RULES AND PENALTIES

INFERNO TEAM will have team starts, that is, the team members will start together. The time will be recorded with an electronic chip and the time recorded by the last member of the team will be valid. We suggest that each team wear the same shirt or the same colors or a distinctive team sign to help the judges and volunteers in carrying out their duties.

TEAM categories

- 3-woman team
- 3-man team
- mixed teams (2 women and 1 man or 2 men and 1 woman)

GENERAL RULES:

The start and finish of the members must be within 60" of each other, that is, no more than one minute can pass between the first and last recorded time. The team starts, runs and finishes together.

Each obstacle must be overcome together following the same line, that is, in each obstacle each team can occupy a maximum of one lane. Without changing the lane chosen by the first athlete, therefore, the second athlete of the team will proceed to overcome the obstacle as soon as the first has touched the bell at the end of the lane and the same will also happen for the third athlete of the team.

There will be obstacles on the course that must be overcome by each team in cooperative mode. As an illustrative but not exhaustive example, there will be transports that must be carried out by the entire team simultaneously, balances or other tests that in any case involve the entire team.

In the case of a competitive race, each member of the team will have 3 bracelets. In order for the team to enter the ranking, each athlete of each PRO team must still have at least one bracelet on their wrist at the time of the Penalty Loop. Each obstacle in suspension will have only 1 attempt. Each failure or failure to overcome an obstacle will result in the cutting of 1 bracelet from the wrist of the athlete who has failed it.

Lost bracelets can be recovered through the Penalty Loop system.

Participants in the TEAM OPEN race will not be required to overcome the obstacle and will not have the three bracelets.

2. DEPARTURE MODE





In order to avoid crowds, departure times for each team will be drawn up and communicated. The departure times will be published on the event website and may vary even on the day itself. Unless otherwise indicated, we recommend arriving at least 90 minutes before the scheduled departure time.

3. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Anyone who is 12 years old or older on the day of the race, women, men, of any nationality, can participate in the event. Minors require authorization from a parent or legal guardian. You can only participate once per race, you sign up for the race, not the battery.

A FUNDAMENTAL REQUIREMENT is the presentation of a valid sports medical certificate for non-competitive activity and a release for minors.

4. METHODS OF CHANGE OR TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF REGISTRATION

Each team may change its participants up to seven (7) days before the race. Each change costs 10 euros. It will not be possible to change the Team participants in the last seven (7) days before the race.

If on the day of the race one or two of the members are unable to participate in the event, the other members of the team who show up on the day of the race may participate in Inferno OPEN individually at no additional cost.

INFERNO reserves the right to modify this document in part or in full. Always view the updated document.

INFORMATION ON DATA PROCESSING (GDPR and PRIVACY) ANDROMEDA SPORT SSD ARL GDPR Information

By asking to participate in the INFERNO race, I declare that I am aware of the characteristics of the race, that I am NOT under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medications; that I am physically prepared and that I am aware that only a careful personal assessment of my own conditions is a guarantee of safety for me and for others. .

1. I release Andromeda Sport SSD arl, its organizers and its staff from any civil and criminal liability and from any compensation for physical, moral and material damages that may occur to me before, during and after the organized activity, even if such damages are caused by acts of third parties and/or other participants. Pursuant to articles 1341 and 1342 of the Civil Code, I explicitly approve the clause relating to the exemption from liability of Andromeda Sport SSD arl. I assume all responsibility for the actions carried out during the activity and for the consequences that may arise from said actions, both civilly and criminally. I fully exonerate Andromeda Sport SSD arl and from any liability for damage to my person and/or to third parties and/or things caused by me. I assume full personal responsibility for my state of health.
2. I also declare that I grant the Organization, or whoever acts for it, the rights to images, photos and videos relating to the race, to authorize the processing of my personal data pursuant to art. 13 of law 675/96 and subsequent, to be aware of the criminal sanctions provided for in the event of untruthful declarations and falsehoods in documents (art. 76 d.p.r. 445/2000 and art. 489 of the penal code).
Furthermore, the undersigned with the signature at the bottom
Declares that he has carefully read in its entirety and accepted fully and without reservations the Regulations of the event.
3. Declares to be fully aware of all the characteristics and specificity of the test, the route, the difficulties and the length of the route, which develops in the mountains with possible difficult weather conditions (such as, by way of example and not limited to, cold, wind, rain, snow, poor visibility, etc.); to be aware of the risks to personal safety associated with the competition; to be an expert in Mountain Running/Trail Running/Skyrunning/Outdoor Running races and aware that participation in this event requires specific preparation and a real capacity for personal autonomy of which he/she certifies to be in possession;
4. Declares not to use doping substances and to be in possession of the medical certificate attesting to the suitability for the practice of sporting activity, to be in good health and exempts the organizers from any liability relating to and consequent to the verification of said suitability;
5. Under penalty of exclusion from the event, he/she undertakes to behave in accordance with the principles of loyalty and fair play during the race and not, under any circumstances, to behave in a manner contrary to the law and the rules of the regulation that may endanger his/her own or others' safety; he/she also undertakes to behave in an environmentally friendly manner during the race, according to the principle of "running without leaving a trace"; He/she assumes all criminal and civil liability, including objective liability, resulting from his/her participation in the event; he/she declares that he/she releases the organizers from any liability, direct and indirect, for any financial and non-financial damages, including future damages, illnesses, and/or injuries, that he/she may suffer, endure and/or cause, including to third parties, during the entire duration of the event and/or on the occasion and/or as a result of his/her participation in it; from any liability related to theft and/or damages possibly suffered by any of his/her personal objects, the custody of which he/she is aware is not assumed in any way by the organizers; and from any liability for damages possibly caused by him/her to third parties and/or to property owned by third parties.
6.
